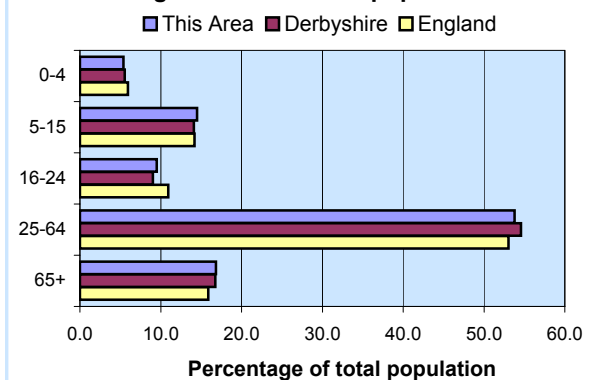

#### Age structure of the population



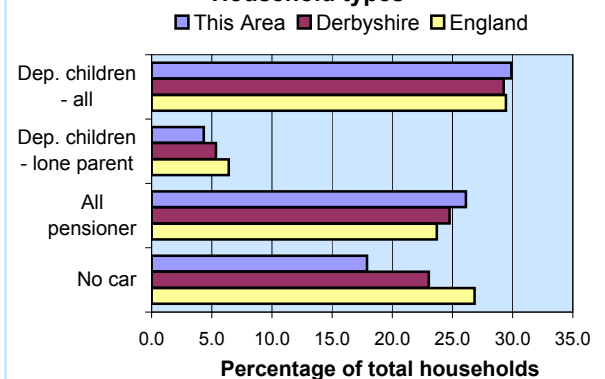
