



Council Tax 2009/10

Briefing Note

Introduction

In February the Council published its 2009/10 budget along with details of Council Tax levels. This note provides an analysis of some of the headline changes in Council Tax at a national and local level.

National Context

In 2009/10 the Band D Equivalent Council Tax for England was £1,413.93, an increase of 3.0% when compared to the 2008/09 average of £1,373.08.

The increase is the second lowest since 1994/95 and compares favourably to the high increases seen in 2003/04 when the average increase hit 12.9%.

Since its introduction in 1993, the average Council Tax bill has more than doubled with average increases of 5.1% per annum. The table below shows the Band D Council Tax since 2000/01.

At a regional level the highest percentage increase in Council Tax is to be found in the North East and South West, at 3.5%, closely followed by the South East (exc. London) at 3.4%. For 2009/10 all regional areas, with the exception of Greater London, had an increase in Council Tax which was above the national average.

The table below shows the Band D Council Tax by region. The figure for East Midlands is higher than the national average of £1,413.93.

At a National Level the Band D Equivalent Council Tax increase for 2009/10 was 3.0%, down on the 2008/09 increase of 4.0%. This year's increases are the lowest in percentage terms since 1994, the second lowest increases were found in 2008/09.

Significant variations in the size of Council Tax bills between local authorities is observed throughout the Country. In terms of poundage levels of Band D bills, they range from £687 in Wandsworth (Greater London) to £1,656 in Rutland (East Midlands).

Most Council Tax bills saw an increase of some degree in England during 2009/10, however Hammersmith and Fulham (Greater London) saw a 2.2% fall on levels from 2008/09 while Camden, Greenwich, Hackney, Lambeth, Southwark, Wandsworth, Westminster, Barking & Dagenham, Ealing, Hounslow, Hillingdon, Newham (all Greater London) saw no change at all with the levels staying as they had during 2008/09. The highest increases were found in Bury (North West) and Trafford (North West) both of which showed an increase of 5.0% from 2008/09.

Despite the fact that the average increases in Council Tax levels are much lower than in past years, there are underlying reasons why increases are to an extent inevitable if local authorities are to maintain appropriate levels of service provision. For example, the size of the taxbase is a key determinant of the average Council Tax. This is the equated number of tax assessments upon which the total requirement is calculated. The taxbase has increased by 0.5% for England and Wales, and because inflation in terms of wages and prices has risen by more than this amount (the all items RPI excluding mortgage interest payments was 2.5% in February), it is inevitable that Council Taxes would need to rise, even to maintain expenditure at a static level.

In 2006/07 the Government decided to opt for the introduction of a Four Block Option of funding. Much of the basis for the new grant distribution remains similar to the previous Formula Spending Share (FSS) system, with a large amount of funding still being distributed according to authorities' relative needs. The intention of the new system is to focus on cash amounts of grant and not on notional measures of spending and Council Tax.

The Government reserves the right to direct an authority to set a lower budget requirement if it considers that the Council Tax or the budget requirement has been increased excessively. The Local Government Minister has made clear the Government's expectations that the average Council Tax increase in England should be substantially below 5% and that it will not hesitate to use capping powers if that proves necessary.

Despite the recommendations made by Sir Michael Lyons in his report published in March 2007, the Government has confirmed that it does not intend to remove the capping powers.

Derbyshire

The County Council set the Band D Equivalent Council Tax for 2009/10 at £1,061.30, an increase of 2.9% against the 2008/09 figure of £1,030.98. The Fire and Police Authority Equivalents were £65.52 and £161.32 respectively.

The average counties increase in 2009/10 was 3.0% with a Band D Equivalent average of £1,077.13. The rates and increase for all counties are set out below. The Derbyshire Band D Equivalent of £1,061.30 was lower than the counties average.

The lowest county increase was Lincolnshire at 1.8%, with Northamptonshire, Warwickshire, Cambridgeshire and North Yorkshire all setting the highest county increase at 3.9%.

Derbyshire set the 6th lowest increase of all counties.

District Level

The table below sets out the Council Tax levels for the district and borough councils, parish councils, fire and police authority within Derbyshire for 2009/10.

Bolsover has the highest Band D Equivalent Total which is largely due to the highest parish council tax level of £95.94.

The highest district / borough Council Band D Equivalent was Derbyshire Dales at £184.23, the lowest being Chesterfield at £136.61. The highest parish Band D amount was Bolsover at £95.94, the lowest being Erewash at £5.49.

The table below shows the Band D Equivalent Council Tax for 2009/10 compared with 2008/09. Chesterfield and Derbyshire Dales had the highest increase of the district / borough councils at 3.9%, with Bolsover registering the lowest increase at 1.8%.

The highest parish increase was in Erewash with an increase of 6.6%, with Derbyshire Dales showing the lowest with a decrease of 0.3%.

The average Council Tax per dwelling for each of the districts is shown in the table below. Derbyshire Dales had the highest average amount at £1,418.83, with Chesterfield being the lowest at £994.02. Erewash had the highest increase of 4.0% with High Peak showing the lowest increases at 2.9%.

The Band D Equivalent amount for Derbyshire Police Authority in 2009/10 was £161.32, a 8.7% increase on the 2008/09 amount of £148.44. In 2009/10 the Fire Authority Band D Equivalent was £65.52, a 4.0% increase on the 2008/09 amount of £62.97. Police and Fire Authority Band D Equivalents for counties are set out in the table below.

The average amount charged for Police Authorities over the counties was £162.49. Derbyshire was the 14th highest (out of 27) Band D amongst counties.

The average amount charged for Fire Authorities (excluding Combined Fire Authorities) over the counties was £64.23. Derbyshire was the 9th highest (out of 16) Band D amongst counties (excluding Combined Fire Authorities).

Conclusion

The Council set a Council Tax increase of 2.9% for 2009/10, which was lower than the counties average of 3.0%.

The Authority's Five Year Financial Plan assumes Council Tax increases of around 3% set by the Council for each year of the plan up-to 2013/14. Spending pressures on statutory services are expected to increase by considerably more than inflation over the coming years. In addition, the worsening economic climate and the subsequent impact on public finances will mean that the Council will find that keeping Council Tax increases at inflationary levels will be a challenge.
