#### What is the Derbyshire Directory?

#### How can I join?

If you represent a voluntary group, club, society or a not-for-profit care service you can register for FREE.

All you have to do is fill in a form online or call the public relations team on **01629 585449** and we will send you one out.

#### What are the benefits?

Organisations listed receive publicity through advertising online as well as posters and leaflets which can help find new members and volunteers where needed.

#### How do I search for groups?

There are three easy ways to search online, using the A-Z if you know the name of the organisation, choosing a specific category, such as disability or arts, or by your town or district. You can also Call Derbyshire on **08456 058 058\*** or go into any Derbyshire County Council library, where a member of staff will help you.
