

GETTING RID OF BUSINESS WASTE

If your business generates or handles waste you have a legal duty to make sure it's dealt with safely and correctly.

Always use a registered waste carrier. It's your responsibility to check and if you don't, you could be fined **£5,000**.

To make sure you stay on the right side of the law:

- Check your waste carrier is registered by calling the Environment Agency on 08708 506 506 or visit www.environment-agency.gov.uk/publicregisters
- Complete a waste transfer note each time you pass on your waste to your carrier and keep it for two years as proof of who took it

If you produce hazardous waste you need to be registered with the Environment Agency. Call **08708 506 506** to register or visit www.environment-agency.gov.uk

GETTING RID OF HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH

Did you know if someone agrees to get rid of your rubbish and dumps it where they shouldn't, they could land you with a **£5,000** fine?

New ways of detecting fly-tipping mean your rubbish could be traced back to you. So the cheapest offer to get rid of it may not be the best if it hits you in the pocket later.

Whether you're throwing out old furniture, building rubble or other unwanted items, make sure the person who's taking your rubbish away is registered.

Many builders, landscape gardeners, skip hire companies and house clearance firms are. But always check to avoid a hefty fine and help reduce the opportunity for rogue traders to fly-tip.

For peace of mind, follow these simple steps:

- Always use a registered carrier
- To find one near you, or check someone is registered, call **08708 506 506** or visit **www.environment-agency.gov.uk/publicregisters**
- Keep a record of their details in case your rubbish is found dumped

You can also get rid of a range of items yourself, including bulky rubbish, for free at Derbyshire County Council's household waste recycling centres in:
