Derbyshire and Derby Joint Structure Plan

Environment Policy 1: Landscape Character

“The Landscape Character of Derbyshire” previously supported the Derby and Derbyshire Joint Structure plan Environment policy 1: Landscape Character.

The character of the landscape will be conserved and enhanced, as appropriate. Development that would have an unacceptable effect on landscape character and diversity will not be permitted. Where development is permitted, opportunities will be taken, as appropriate, to conserve, enhance and restore the local distinctiveness, character and diversity of the landscape.

In 2007 this was superseded by policies in the Regional Spatial Strategy (RSS) and emerging policies in the County, District and Borough Council Local Development Frameworks.
