Introduction

This list gives covering dates and collection reference numbers of parish registers which have been deposited in the Record Office as Diocesan Record Office for the Diocese of Derby under the *Parochial Register and Records Measure (1978, amended 1992)*

This list is arranged alphabetically by name of parish or chapelry, Some hamlets are also included and cross-referenced to the relevant parish Under the name of each parish or chapelry are brief notes detailing the areas covered. In the case of new parishes and chapelries, dates of formation and licensing for particular functions are given.

Overall covering dates have been given for the registers held in the original and on microfilm. Major gaps because of loss of registers are noted. Registers after the last date given remain in the parish.

To consult individual registers in the Derbyshire Record Office Search Room, you need item reference numbers from the archival catalogue for the specific parish collection, available in hard copy in the Record Office Search Room.
