

Notes

The **unemployment** worksheet contains a combination of both "official" (i.e. published) and "unofficial" (i.e. calculated by the R & I Team) figures.

Official figures

The official figures consist of unemployment numbers by sex, and for selected ages and durations, for the following areas:-

- England
- East Midlands
- Derbyshire (administrative county) *
- Derby City *
- Travel to Work Areas (all that cover any part of Derbyshire)
- Local Authority Districts within Derbyshire *
- Wards (2001 Census) within Derbyshire, Derby City and the Peak District National Park †

The official figures also include unemployment rates by gender for all the areas listed above.

** These areas are defined in terms of 1991 Census wards.*

† Peak Park wards are all those that cover any part of the Park and have population within the area of overlap.

Unofficial figures

The unemployment rates for young people (shown italicised in green) are unofficial figures. They have been calculated by expressing the number of claimants in each age group as percentage of the total number of people in that age group as given in the 2001 Census.

Unemployment rates

Official unemployment rates are only available for total claimants by gender. They are calculated by expressing the number of claimants as a percentage of the working age population (males 16-64, females 16-59) as given in the mid-year population estimates published by the Office for National Statistics (ONS). The date of the mid-year estimates can vary between different types of area. The notes at the top of the spreadsheet indicate the current situation.

Unemployment rates for specific age groups have been calculated by the R & I Team - see **Unofficial figures** above.

Age and duration figures

A very small proportion of unemployment claimant records are held manually rather than on computer. Breakdowns of unemployment figures by age and duration are only available for computerised records. The **unemployment** worksheet shows a separate total for computerised records and the proportions of under 25 year olds and long-term unemployed are calculated in relation to this total.

The numbers unemployed are those recorded in the monthly count of people who are claiming unemployment-related benefits. Figures for specific ages/durations are for computerised claims only (compare "total" and "comp total").

Denominators:- For areas shown in blue, the denominators used to calculate all-age unemployment rates are derived from the 2008 mid-year estimates of working age population. For all other areas, the denominators are derived from the 2007 mid-year estimates.

Rates for young unemployed people (shown in green italics) are unofficial figures. They have been calculated using denominators from the 2007 Mid-Year Population Estimates which, in the case of wards, are classified by ONS as experimental.

Rounding:- To preserve confidentiality, figures for specific ages/durations are rounded to the nearest 5. Elsewhere, values of 1 and 2 are suppressed (indicated by #).

Geography:- Derbyshire refers to the administrative county as established on 1 April 1997 which excludes the City of Derby. The boundary of the Peak District National Park does not follow ward boundaries and many wards are split. All of the wards listed under Peak Park in this table have more than 50% of its population resident within the national park, but those shown in italics have less than 100%. Two totals are shown: one for just those wards where 100% of the population is resident in the national park; and the other for all wards with more than 50% of the population resident in the park.
