MANDATORY CYCLE LANE ORDER 2022

Derbyshire County Council hereby gives notice that it proposes to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be, in respects of roads in the Borough of Chesterfield and North East Derbyshire. The effect of which will be that no vehicle other than a pedal cycle, shall be permitted to enter, proceed or wait in the mandatory cycle lane on the following length of road:

MANDATORY CYCLE LANE

Chatsworth Road / Baslow Road North Side

From its junction with Storrs Road in a westerly direction for a distance of 1300 metres.
