2020/43	<u>The Food for Specific Groups (Food for Special Medical Purposes for Infants, Infant Formula and Follow-on Formula) (Information and Compositional Requirements) (Amendment etc.) (England) Regs 2020</u>	Food Safety Act 1990 and European Communities Act 1972	This instrument provides the enforcement regime for the second part of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/128 on food for special medical purposes (FSMP) developed to satisfy the nutritional requirements of infants, and for Delegated Regulation (EU) 2016/127 on infant formula and follow-on formula (IFFOF). It provides the penalties for breaching these updated EU rules on FSMP for infants and IFFOF.	In accordance with reg. 1
2020/127	<u>The Code of Practice for the Welfare of Pigs (Appointed Day and Revocation) (England) Order 2020</u>	Animal Welfare Act 2006	This Order appoints 1st March 2020 as the day on which the Code of Practice for the Welfare of Pigs comes into force in England. Article 3 revokes the previous Code of Recommendations for the Welfare of Livestock: Pigs. Article 4 provides that the new Code of Practice will not apply to proceedings relating to any alleged act causing unnecessary suffering to an animal committed before 01.03.20. In such cases, the previous Code of Recommendations will continue to apply. This is for the purposes of section 14(4) of the Animal Welfare Act 2006, which provides that failure to comply with a relevant provision of a code of practice may be relied upon as tending to establish liability, and compliance with a relevant provision of	01.03.2020

2020/187	<u>The Video Recordings (Labelling) (Amendment) Regs 2020</u>	Video Recordings Act 1984	This instrument amends the Video Recordings (Labelling) Regs 2012 ("the 2012 Regs") in order to change the requirements for certain age rating symbols, which must be shown on video recordings and other products containing video works for which a classification certificate has been issued by the video works authority. The intention of this instrument is to refresh the statutory requirements as to age rating symbols, by simplifying the way they appear visually, making them more logical and easier to read in order to improve consumer decision-making and increase public protection from inappropriate material.	06.04.2020
2020/256	<u>The Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2020</u>	Food Safety Act 1990	This instrument amends the Addition of Vitamins, Minerals and Other Substances (England) Regs 2007 to include provisions to allow Regulation (EC) 1925/2006 to be fully enforced in England. It provides the offences and penalties for breaching the rules on restricted or prohibited substances.	03.04.2020
