Revision of the Police and Crime Plan 2016-21

Thank you for your letter of 23rd March confirming the outcome of the discussion by the Police and Crime Panel about my proposed revisions to the Police and Crime Plan for Derbyshire 2016-21. I am grateful to the panel for their careful consideration of my proposed revisions and their acceptance of them without reservation.

During the discussion I was aware that some members of the Panel were concerned that removing a specific strategic priority around partnership working could mean a dilution of the drive to work using a partnership approach and I would like to take this opportunity to reassure those members that I am very alive to this issue and, as discussed at the panel meeting, feel that the adoption of a partnership approach forms a strong narrative throughout the plan and will be an approach that I am committed to retaining moving forward.
