
Overall, how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with your local area as a place to live?



How safe do you feel in your neighbourhood (i.e. the roads and streets around your home) in the following situations? (When outside during the day)
















How well informed do you feel about each of the following: (What happens to waste (non -recycling) when you throw it away)




How well informed do you feel about each of the following: (The new waste treatment centre being built in Sinfin, Derby)


Derwent Valley Mills World Heritage Site

Derbyshire has the only World Heritage Site in the East Midlands. Stretching from Matlock Bath to Derby, the Derwent Valley World Heritage Site has been designated by UNESCO as it is the site of the world's earliest modern factories and worker's housing. These include the mills and housing at Cromford, Belper, Milford, Darley Abbey and Derby which pioneered the factory system in the late 18th century. The Site is coordinated by a partnership of local authorities and organisations which include Derbyshire County Council. 
