

## **Derbyshire County Integrated Sexual Health Service Consultation Stage 2: The Integrated Sexual Health Service Model**

The purpose of Stage 2 of the consultation is to seek input into the development of the Integrated Sexual Health Service Model and to provide feedback from Stage 1 of the consultation.

### **Feedback from Consultation Stage 1**

A review of Sexual Health Services in Derbyshire (including Glossopdale) has been undertaken. A paper was submitted to Cabinet on 25 March 2014 to present the overall findings of the Review and to seek approval of all recommendations and the specific recommendation to re-procure an Integrated Sexual Health Service. Approval was granted and a tendering process will be undertaken to commission a Derbyshire County Integrated Sexual Health Service to commence 01 April 2015. Throughout stage 1 of the review of Derbyshire Sexual Health Services, opportunities to consult with stakeholders and service users have been undertaken as follows:

1. Focus groups with actual and potential service users, aimed to reach individuals representative of high risk groups
2. Consultation workshop with existing Derbyshire providers (including Glossopdale)
3. Online consultation for members of the public, service users and other stakeholders
4. Meetings with other commissioners and stakeholders.

### **Consultation Stage 2**

#### ***The Integrated Sexual Health Service Proposed Model***

The Integrated Sexual Health Services shall provide directly and sub contract high quality, open access, confidential and cost effective provision of:

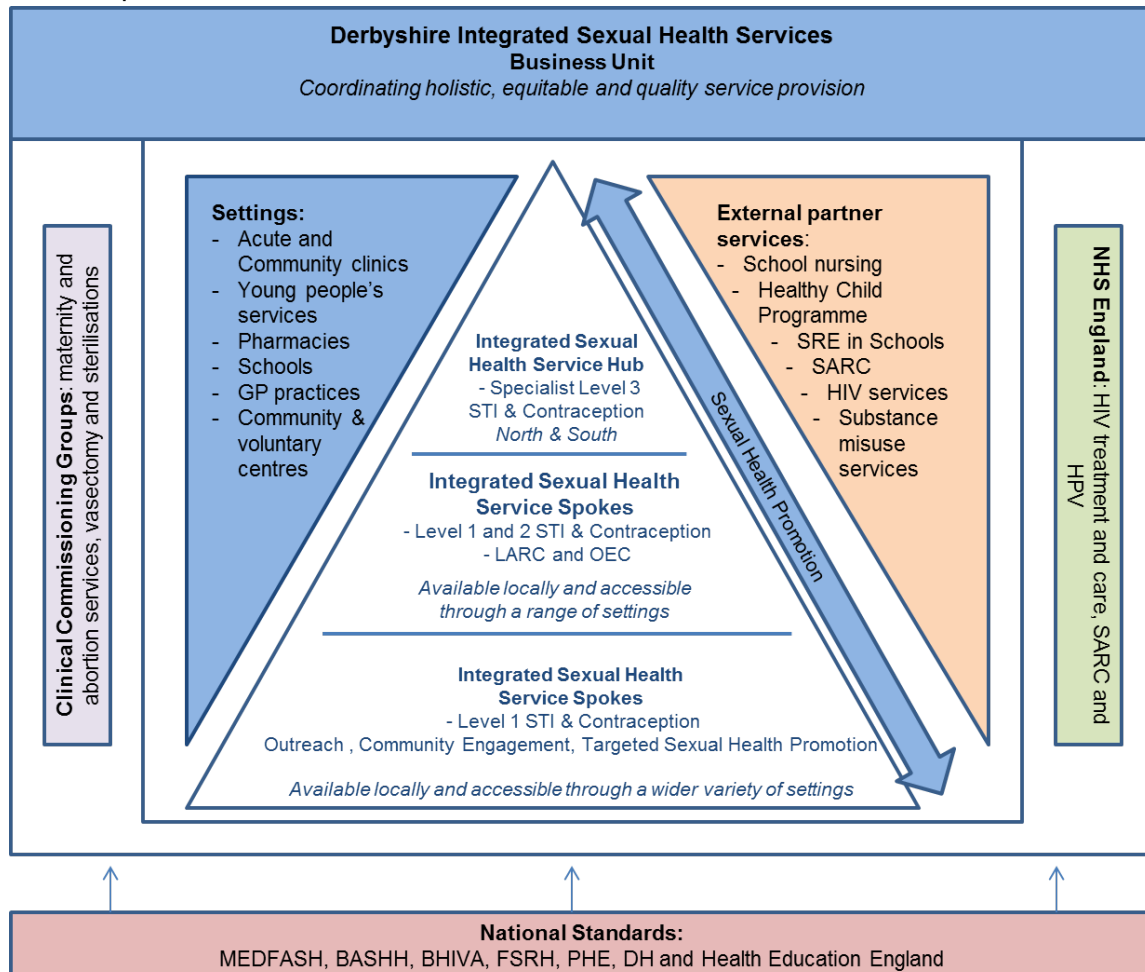
- Level 1 – 3 STI testing and treatment including partner notification
- Level 1 – 3 Contraception (including provision of LARC and OEC)
- Sexual health aspects of psychosexual counselling
- Targeted sexual health promotion and HIV prevention
- Condom distribution
- Laboratory testing for chlamydia screening

The final Integrated Sexual Health Service Model will be developed and negotiated following the tender process.



The Integrated sexual health service Hubs will offer level 3 STI testing and treatment and contraception services and the coordination, leadership and management of the whole service through a business unit. Level 3 STI testing and treatment and contraception will be made available as appropriate outside of the Hubs to increase provision across the County.

The delivery of level 1 and 2 STI testing and treatment, contraception and targeted sexual health promotion, outreach and HIV prevention will be delivered in and from 'spoke' locations. The delivery of sexual health promotion, information and outreach to prevent poor sexual health, reduce repeat STI's or onwards transmission will be delivered throughout the whole service.

### Locations

The locations of the Integrated Sexual Health Service will of course be for determination and negotiation following the tender process. However it is envisaged that there will be 2 Hubs in the North and South of the County, offering Level 3 interventions. There will be multiple Spokes positioned across the County in order to meet the need of service users; improve access; avoid multiple visits; reduce duplication of services. Spokes must be designed flexibility to respond to changing need among service users. Spokes will be delivered in

diverse settings including community clinics, general practice, pharmacy, voluntary sector. The Spokes will deliver Level 1 and/or Level 2 STI testing and Treatment and Contraception and targeted sexual health promotion.

Please note that when interpreting the map, the areas for the Hub and Spoke locations are purely a guide based on population size of 15 – 24 year olds (the age group most using sexual health services). Provision will not be limited to these areas, additional provision will be available through other locations (e.g. general practice, pharmacy and the voluntary sector). The areas for consideration are not intended to be reflective of the number of clinics and opening times.
