**NEW INSTRUMENTS OF GOVERNMENT**

**Purpose of the Report**

To agree new Instruments of Government to be made under the School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012.

**Information and Analysis**

The following proposals have been received from school Governing Bodies and they comply with the requirements of the Regulations:-

- (1) Hady Primary School - 11 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (2) Stonelow Juniors School – 9 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 3 co-opted governors.
- (3) Great Hucklow CE Primary School – 8 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 2 Foundation governors.
- (4) Bamford Primary School – 10 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 3 co-opted governors.
- (5) Springwell Community College – 13 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 8 co-opted governors.
- (6) Woodbridge Junior School – 10 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (7) Duckmanton Primary School – 12 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (8) Somerlea Park Junior School – 11 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 6 co-opted governors.
- (9) Hathersage St Michael's CE Voluntary Aided Primary School – 14 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 1 co-opted and 8 Foundation governors.

- (10) Lons Infant School – 7 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 2 co-opted governors.
- (11) Stanton Vale Special School – 10 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (12) Loscoe CE Primary School – 12 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 3 co-opted and 3 Foundation governors.
- (13) Barlow CE Voluntary Controlled Primary School – 10 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 3 co-opted and 2 Foundation governors.
- (14) Langley Mill Junior School – 10 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (15) Swanwick Primary School – 15 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 10 co-opted governors.
- (16) Poolsbrook Primary School – 9 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 3 co-opted governors.
- (17) Tibshelf Infant and Nursery School – 12 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
