**NEW INSTRUMENTS OF GOVERNMENT**

**Purpose of the Report**

To agree new Instruments of Government to be made under the School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012.

**Information and Analysis**

The following proposals have been received from school Governing Bodies and they comply with the requirements of the Regulations:-

(1) The Governing Body of the New Whittington Community Primary School has asked that the Instrument of Government for the School be amended to provide for a new Governing Body of 11 members comprising 5 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 3 co-opted governors.

(2) The Governing Body of the Granville Sports College has asked that the Instrument of Government for the School be amended to provide for a new Governing Body of 18 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 11 co-opted governors.
