To agree new Instruments of Government to be made under the School Governance (Constitution) (England) Regulations 2012.

Information and Analysis

The following proposals have been received from school Governing Bodies and they comply with the requirements of the Regulations:-

- (1) Cutthorpe Primary School - 9 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 3 co-opted governors.
- (2) St George's CE Controlled Primary School - 8 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 2 Foundation and 1 co-opted governors.
- (3) Pottery Primary School - 13 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 8 co-opted governors. As existing co-opted governors' terms of office come to an end, the membership of the Governing Body will reduce to 10 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (4) Bradwell CE Controlled Infant School - 10 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 2 Foundation and 3 co-opted governors.
- (5) Shirland Primary School - 11 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (6) Ripley St John's CE Voluntary Controlled Primary School - 16 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 4 Foundation and 5 co-opted governors.
- (7) All Saints CE Voluntary Controlled Junior School - 14 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 3 Foundation and 4 co-opted governors.
- (8) Chapel en le Frith CE Voluntary Controlled Primary School - 15 members comprising 6 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 3 Foundation and 3 co-opted governors.

- (9) Parwich Primary School - 9 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 3 co-opted governors.
- (10) Bramley Vale Primary School - 11 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 4 co-opted governors.
- (11) Holbrook Centre for Autism - 11 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (12) Barrow Hill Primary School - 9 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 3 co-opted governors.
- (13) Copthorne Infant School - 11 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 4 co-opted governors.
- (14) Croft Infant School - 11 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 4 co-opted governors.
- (15) The Green Infant School - 12 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (16) Long Row Primary School - 11 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (17) Hasland Hall Community School - 18 members comprising 5 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 10 co-opted governors.
- (18) Rosliston Church of England Primary School - 10 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 2 Foundation and 2 co-opted governors.
- (19) Dallimore Primary School - 12 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 5 co-opted governors.
- (20) Dove Holes CE Voluntary Controlled Primary School - 13 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher, 2 Foundation and 4 co-opted governors.
- (21) Harpur Hill Primary School - 12 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 6 co-opted governors.
- (22) Larkland Infant and Nursery School - 11 members comprising 4 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 4 co-opted governors.
- (23) Spire Junior School - 12 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 6 co-opted governors.
- (24) Spire Nursery and Infant School - 14 members comprising 3 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 8 co-opted governors.
- (25) Grindleford Primary School - 9 members comprising 2 parents, 1 Local Authority, 1 Staff, 1 Headteacher and 4 co-opted governors.
