BELPER SCHOOL AND SIXTH FORM CENTRE SECTION 106 FUNDING

1. Purpose of Report

To seek approval for the release of Section 106 funding to Belper School and Sixth Form Centre.

2. Information and Analysis

A sum of £208,772.58 has been received from Amber Valley Borough Council on behalf of Wheeldon Brothers Ltd, as included in the Section 106 Planning Agreement for a housing development approved in July 2010, at Nottingham Road, Belper,

Belper School and Sixth Form Centre has identified a range of projects to improve education facilities at the School which meet the CIL (Community Infrastructure Levy) regulations. These projects focus on creating a classroom for teaching the PE curriculum.

Belper School and Sixth Form centre will manage the projects.

3. Financial Considerations

Belper School and Sixth Form Centre has costed a programme of projects for the development of their site to be funded using the S106 funding received from Wheeldon Brothers Ltd. There is no financial commitment from the Local Authority.

4. Social Value Considerations

This funding will be provided to the Governing body of the school who will be responsible for the procurement. A procurement of this size is expected to meet Outcome 1 of the Social Value Procurement Framework

(A strong local economy). It will be a condition of funding that the Governing body take account of Social Value in their procurement and that they record the percentage of the spend that is supporting the local supply chain (% of total spend within Derbyshire or within a 10 mile radius).
