33/16 CONSULTATION : SOUTH DERBYSHIRE LOCAL PLAN PART 2
 South Derbyshire District Council (SDDC) submitted the South Derbyshire Local Plan Part 1 (LPPt1) to the Secretary of State in August 2014 and an Examination in Public (EIP) was held in November and December 2014. In response to the provisional findings, SDDC carried out further work to address a number of

outstanding issues and the EIP was resumed on 8 and 9 December 2015 with a number of Local Plan hearing sessions. On 28 January 2016, SDDC published Main Modifications to the LPpt1, which were currently the subject of a separate public consultation exercise.

SDDC has now commenced work preparing the LPpt2 which sets out more detailed local development management policies to guide future development on matters such as settlement boundaries; housing development in urban and rural area; the built and natural environment; education; retail and town centres and infrastructure provision. In order to meet the statutory deadline of 12 February 2016 for the submission of comments, provisional informal Member and Officer technical comments were submitted on the LPpt2, subject to agreement at this Cabinet Member meeting.

RESOLVED that officers be authorised to send a formal response to South Derbyshire District Council in response to its public consultation on the South Derbyshire Local Plan Part 2, in line with the comments set out in the report.

34/16 CHARGING FOR THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION CONTAINED WITHIN THE HISTORIC ENVIRONMENT RECORD AND FOR DATA RELATING TO THE LANDSCAPE CHARACTER OF DERBYSHIRE DOCUMENT

Derbyshire County Council maintains, on behalf of Derbyshire, the Historic Environment Record (HER), a comprehensive record of the historic environment of Derbyshire, comprising digital and paper documentary sources. For many years the County Council, in common with most other holders of HERs, charged for providing information from the HER for commercial users of the information. Access to the information held on the HER was free to members of the public and researchers by appointment at the County Council's Shand House office.

The Landscape Character of Derbyshire (LCoD) was freely available on the County Council's website and could be downloaded as PDFs. From time to time consultants ask the Conservation and Design Section for a 'clipped' area of the information held in MapInfo to save them from having to digitize the boundaries themselves when compiling visual impact assessments as part of planning applications or environmental impact assessments.

It was proposed to charge for the provision of data from HER and LCoD undertaken by the HER officer and Landscape Technician. The charge would need to reflect the actual cost and it was suggested that the charging regime was monitored annually. The recovery cost for standard commercial searches of the HER was calculated at £35.01 per hour. The report also detailed costs for more complex requests.

RESOLVED to approve charging for the provision of information contained within the Historic Environment Record and for 'clipping' the data relating to the Landscape Character of Derbyshire as set out in the report.
