57/15 **PETITION - REQUEST TO EXTEND 30MPH SPEED LIMIT – A608, MORLEY** The item was deferred pending further information.

59/15 **BROOKHILL LANE, PINXTON - PROPOSED 7.5 TONNES WEIGHT RESTRICTION ORDER – OBJECTION FROM NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL** Following requests concerning an increase in the amount of Heavy Goods Vehicles (HGVs) using Brookhill Lane, Pinxtton, consultations, including advertisement on site, on the introduction of a 7.5 tonnes Weight Restriction Order have been undertaken.

Responses received from both Nottinghamshire Constabulary and Derbyshire Constabulary expressed concern regarding the amount of enforcement they could provide. The objection from a local Nottinghamshire County Council Member concerned possible displacement of HGV's along roads in Nottinghamshire, the Member requested details of possible safeguards that could be put in place to mitigate the concerns.

It was not possible to terminate a weight limit at the County Boundary and Nottinghamshire County Council would also need to approve the weight limit

contained in Nottinghamshire. Should Nottinghamshire County Council reject the proposal, it would be recommended that the Derbyshire proposal be withdrawn as the potential solution was unworkable.

RESOLVED that (1) Derbyshire County Council provides Nottinghamshire County Council with a copy of this report to be considered by its Highways and Transport Committee; and

(2) Derbyshire County Council produces a further report, once a decision has been taken by Nottinghamshire County Council, on the proposal as advertised.

60/15 AWARD OF GRANTS TO EXTERNAL RECIPIENTS

RESOLVED to approve the award of grant of £1,200 to Ticknall Archaeological Research Group to commission chemical analysis on selected pottery fragments.

61/15 GREEN TONIC PROJECT – SERVICE LEVEL AGREEMENT

The Countryside Service secured £30,000 of funding from the Public Health Resource fund for a project in the Clowne area of Bolsover District working with volunteers and people who were referred by health professionals as a means to improving their wellbeing.

Working with Groundwork Creswell would provide an affordable way of achieving Derbyshire County Council and Countryside Service objectives around health outcomes, participation and conservation and environmental improvement. Groundwork Creswell was also well established in the Clowne area, could establish project quickly in the new financial year and was experienced in the management of volunteer tasks, activities and reporting result and outcomes of projects.

RESOLVED to approve the placing of a work order for the Service Level Agreement with Groundwork Creswell for up to £30,000 under Protocol 8 of the Council's Financial Regulations.
