LOCAL GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION SUBSCRIPTION 2013/2014

Purpose of the Report

To approve the Council's subscription to the Local Government Association for 2013/2014.

Information and Analysis

The Council's membership of the Local Government Association is due for renewal for 2013/14 and the subscription is £70,381. This compares with £72,245 in 2012/13, £76,602 in 2011/12 and £87,468 in 2010/11. The LGA is the voice of local government and its members include each of the three main political parties. As such it leads on a number of campaigns on behalf of local authorities.

Financial Considerations

The subscription cost can be met from provision included in the Council's revenue budget.
