**ADDITION TO THE CAPITAL PROGRAMME 2012/13 - LONG  
EATON TOWN CENTRE – FOOTWAY RESURFACING AND  
CREATION OF NEW BUS BOARDING AREAS (HIGHWAYS AND  
TRANSPORT)**

(1) **Purpose of the Report** To seek Cabinet approval to include a scheme to carry out the construction of bus boarding facilities and footway resurfacing within Long Eaton Town Centre in the 2012/13 Capital Programme.

(2) **Information and Analysis** Erewash Borough Council has successfully secured funding through “Growth Point” for its Long Eaton Sustainable Transport Project. A part of the project comprises improvements to footways in Long Eaton Town Centre, including new bus boarding facilities at the main bus stops on Nottingham Road at The Green, and on Tamworth Road, near the junction with High Street. In order for the works to take place, an agreement under Section 278 has been secured with Erewash Borough Council.

The construction works for these improvements has been awarded to Derbyshire County Council’s ALLRoads Section. Works are expected to be completed by December 2012.

(3) **Financial Considerations** The estimated cost of the works is £66,500 and will be met in full by Erewash Borough Council.

(4) **Property Considerations** There are no property considerations associated with this report.

In preparing this report the relevance of the following factors has been considered: legal, prevention of crime and disorder, equality and diversity, human resources, environmental, health and transport considerations.

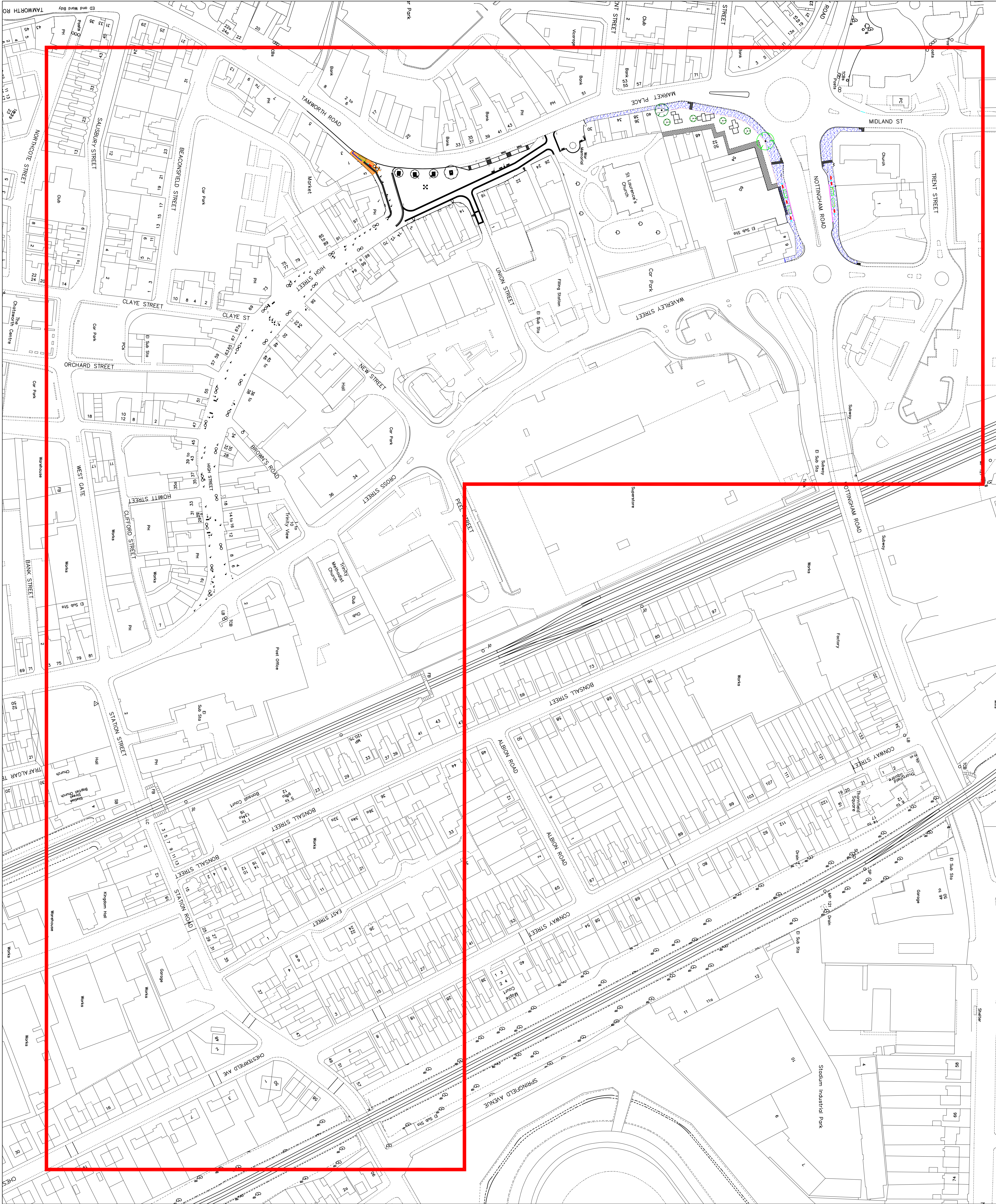
