

Motion 1 submitted by Councillor S Flitter –

Recognised Fair Trade towns are now playing a vital role in supporting the excellent work of many volunteers in ensuring fairness on a range of issues from minimum wages, health and safety, protection of workers and a sustainable trading commitment.

In September 2004 Cabinet welcomed and supported the Fair Trade initiative with recommendations to promote and purchase (where possible) fair trade products. Fair trade town status has to be re-applied for every 2/3 years and this Council's support is an important part of any application,

“Noting the growing successes of the fair trade initiative throughout Derbyshire, this Council re-affirms its support and commitment by updating existing publicity and promoting and purchasing fair trade products wherever and whenever the opportunity arises”.

Motion 2 submitted by Councillor Ms A Western –

This Council recognises the high level of public concern about the proposals to close the DCC universal youth service. This Council requires the Cabinet Member for Young People to:

1. Conduct a centre by centre review of DCC youth work to evaluate its effectiveness and value to young people
2. Review the impact of part-time youth worker job losses on multi-agency team effectiveness
3. Commit to a process of local dialogue with young people before any changes are introduced
