Recap

- NHS England Assurance Process, Oct 17 - Consultation not required
- Improvement & Scrutiny Committee , Nov 17 – satisfied with proposals for public engagement
- CCG comprehensive engagement period – 17 January to 31 March 2018
- Came to ISC to update on findings so far on 12 March
- Attending today to provide update on engagement findings.

Engagement

In summary:

- 1359 People spoken to
- 3226 Joined up Care Belper documents distributed
- 26,082 Flyers distributed
- In total staff spent over 140 hours talking to local people about plans

- Belper News two stories = 1908 readers
- Amber Valley Info- two stories = 2750 readers
- Derby Evening Telegraph- three stories= 110562 readers
- Total media reach 115220

GPs:

It was and continues to be very important for the CCG to work with local GPs to understand how best to develop services for the future. Two letters of support for the plans can be found in the engagement report.

Feedback

- Survey asked three questions and asked for comments
- Feedback came from a letter, 2 emails, information provided on the have your say section on the Southern Derbyshire CCG website and 172 responses to the questionnaire
- There were also letters from Riversdale and Appletree PPGs
- All feedback was analysed and themes produced
- Review by Healthwatch to ensure there is no unconscious bias in the theming

Responses

Question 1- Do you agree with the proposal to stop providing NHS services from Babington Hospital?

Question 2- Do you agree with the proposal to build a new purpose build facility in the centre of Belper to provide NHS services?

No	48	79

Question 3 asked people to add further comments which are captured in the themes.

Themes

- Agreement with plans to have a new build and transfer services
- Need more information or detail about the plans- cost of refurbishment and feasibility study
- There is nothing wrong with the site now- do not see the need for change
- Concern there will be a cut of beds and misunderstanding of how the new bed model will work
- Issues with access and car parking at new site

Themes

- Feeling there may be a reduction in services- questions around what existing services will transfer across
- Concern for the future of the building- Historic significance
- Questions about future services and whether plans include future proofing and reference that Belper is a growing town
- Staffing for the new build- concerns about social care staffing levels
- Questions about the high profile recent winter pressures where Acute Hospitals have experienced capacity issues and whether the community hospitals could alleviate pressures

Governance Timescales

- May 2018 - Review Healthwatch Derbyshire - in progress
- May 2018 - Present engagement findings to ISC
- 23 June 2018 - SDCCG Governing Body decision on future plans
- TBC - Instruction to DCHS about next steps
- 28 June 2018 - Meeting with Belper PPG Chairs
- TBC - Update website with next steps
- TBC – Information displayed in Babington Hospital and GP Practices about next steps as well as media update

Next steps

- Capital money £6m has been secured from Department of Health and Social Care by Derbyshire Community Health Services (DCHS) for this build (if it is approved)
- If Governing Body approve plans DCHS will be working on finalising the planning application
- Work will then start to deliver the new build working with Derbyshire County Council Adult Care who hope to start their part of the build on site in the next few months
