

MINUTES of a meeting of **the IMPROVEMENT AND SCRUTINY COMMITTEE – PEOPLE** held at County Hall, Matlock on 6 July 2016.

16/16 **MINUTES RESOLVED** that the Minutes of the meeting of the Committee held on 18 May 2016 be confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Chair.

17/16 **CHILDREN'S ENGAGEMENT WORK – HEALTHWATCH DERBYSHIRE** Ms H Hart presented the report 'Your Shout!' which highlighted young people's experiences of the health and social care services available to them in Derbyshire. Many of the findings relating to appointment times were similar to adult responses. Other issues covered included sexual health; use of pharmacists; anxiety, depression and worries; mental health; disabled children's services, multi-agency teams, social worker and sensory teams; young carers; and a happier and healthier life. It was agreed that the report was a useful document and would be shared with other service providers.

Ms Hart provided updates on the CAMHS report and the Autism report, which had previously been presented to the Committee. Action plans for both reports were being prepared. A briefing note on the national study undertaken on improving children's access to mental health services would be circulated to Members.

RESOLVED to note the findings of Children's Engagement Work and that the Safeguarding Sub-Group consider the points contained in the summary of findings.

18/16 **ELIGIBILITY THRESHOLDS REVIEW PROGRESS REPORT** A progress report was presented on the evaluation of the impact of the change in Fair Access to Care Services (FACS) eligibility on former Adult Care service users and how their wellbeing had fared since their service had finished. Research had indicated that the majority of clients (70%) had managed reasonably well with support from family and community resources, whilst some had achieved greater independence. The remaining 30% of clients had found it difficult to cope and some had returned for support from Adult Care.

RESOLVED to note the progress report.

19/16 REVIEW OF TRANSITION TO ADULTHOOD - SCOPING REPORT A scoping report for the proposed review of Transition to Adulthood was presented. The review would consider the following:

- The current provision of support to young people in their transition to adulthood, especially those with additional needs or disabilities.
- Models of provision and best practice in transition planning and how partners work together in the support in young people's transition.

RESOLVED (1) to agree the scope of the review of the transition to adulthood; and

(2) that the review working group consist of Councilors Mrs G Birkin, J Frudd (Chair), P Gilby and D Walton.

20/16 CONFIRMATION OF SAFEGUARDING WORKING GROUP MEMBERSHIP **RESOLVED** to confirm that the membership of the Safeguarding Working Group consist Councilors G Birkin, D Charles (Chair), K Lauro, B Ridgway and D Walton.

21/16 HATE CRIME REVIEW PROGRESS REPORT A progress report on the review of Hate Crime was presented and a summary of the four lines of inquiry were given. It was anticipated that the final review report would be presented at the September meeting.
