Review of transition to adulthood

Scoping Report

1. Purpose of the Report

To inform Members of the scope of the transition to adulthood scrutiny review.

2. Information and Analysis

This review will contribute to the Council Plan pledge to deliver “A Derbyshire that cares” with “Thriving children, young people and families”. In particular the stated priority for 2016/17 to: “further improve support for young people into adulthood through transition planning, working across health, education, adult care and children’s services”.

The review of how the authority is supporting those people with additional needs or disabilities has been proposed by the Strategic Director, Adult Care and supported by the Cabinet Member for Adult Social Care. Following initial discussions with relevant officers and Members, the scope of the review has been proposed.

The review will consider the following:

- the current provision of support to young people in their transition to adulthood, especially those with additional needs or disabilities.
- models of provision and best practice in transition planning and how partners work together in the support in young people’s transition.

The review will explore ways to capture the views of those who receive services to support the transition from young child to adulthood especially those with additional needs or disabilities.

3. Potential Information Sources

The review will seek evidence from the following:

- Relevant officers from Children’s Services and Adult Care including Public Health

- Cabinet Member for Health and Communities
- Cabinet Member for Children Services
- Cabinet Member for Adult Social Care
- Strategic Director of Adult Care
- Strategic Director of Children Services
- Derbyshire Children's Trust Board
- Derbyshire Health and Wellbeing Board
- Youth Council Members, young people, particularly those with disabilities and their Carers
- Groups and organisations which support young children with disabilities and their carers, including advocacy, careers advice, educational advice, apprenticeships, financial advice
- School Forums
- Clinical Commissioning Groups.

The review will be completed by March 2017.

A working group will be appointed by this Committee to undertake the review and submit progress reports and a final report to the full Committee at the conclusion of the review.

4. Officer's Recommendations

The Committee is requested to;

- (1) Agree the scope of the review of the transition to adulthood and;
- (2) Appoint Members of the Committee to the review working group.
