WORK PROGRAMME 2016/17

1. Purpose of the Report

To consider the Improvement and Scrutiny Committee - People work programme for 2016/17.

2. Information

The Committee is currently undertaking one scrutiny review on hate crime. It is proposed that a final review report will be considered by the Committee on 7 September. The child sexual exploitation (CSE) review was agreed at the Cabinet meeting on 14 June with all recommendations accepted. An action plan to implement all the recommendations is now being prepared and the Committee will be updated at a future date on its progress. The standing working group on safeguarding, which conducted the CSE review is looking at safeguarding performance of the authority in July and will update the Committee at a future date.

A review into how the authority is working with partners on the transition to adulthood has been proposed and the scoping report is being considered by the Committee today.

Appendix one provides the current and planned work programme. Further reviews can be approved to be included in the work programme at the Chair's agreement.
