27/15 **ADULT CARE ELIGIBILITY THRESHOLD CHANGES** R Miller, Adult Care Department, attended to outline the progress that had been made implementing the recommendations arising from the review of the eligibility threshold changes.

28/15 **SCRUTINY REPORT ON STARTING POINT** The progress made in implementing the recommendations arising from the Committee's review of Starting Point was reported.

29/15 **HEALTHWATCH DERBYSHIRE** Ms H Hart, Healthwatch Derbyshire, presented their reports on the experience of using Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services in the County, as told by young people,

parents, carers and professionals. The report was in two parts – one for North Derbyshire and one for Southern Derbyshire. The reports made a number of recommendations and the response from service providers and commissioners was set out.

RESOLVED that the reports be welcomed and the Committee's view that increased resources were needed by CAMHS be conveyed to the Derbyshire Health and Wellbeing Board.

30/15 **CHILD SEXUAL EXPLOITATION REVIEW – PROGRESS REPORT** An update was presented on the work undertaken to date by the working group undertaking the review of child sexual exploitation.
