Condition 3 - Breach of Condition Notice issued 8 March 2012 requiring the cessation of use of processing plant outside the building.	Pre-application enquiry response provided to applicant. Awaiting submission of planning application.
Rainbow Waste, Swadlincote.	Storage of waste outside the building.	Breach of Condition Notice served on 17 November 2012 for cessation of storage and removal of external waste and concrete "A" frames by 17 December 2012.	Continued liaison with the operator regarding ongoing breaches and regularising applications.

CP Environmental Ltd, Markham Vale, Duckmanton, Chesterfield	Condition 6 of Planning Permission CW2/0215/144. Breach involves the unloading, deposit, storage and transfer of waste material (not consisting of wood, hardcore or soils) outside the Waste Transfer building.	Breach of Condition Notice issued 9 November 2017.	Notice requires: i) cessation of unloading, deposit, storage or transfer of waste material outside the waste Transfer building except for the unloading, deposit, storage or transfer of wood, hardcore or soils within the external storage bays – Time for compliance - 11 December 2017; ii) the removal, or relocation to within the Waste Transfer building, of all waste material stored outside the building unless it is wood, hardcore or soils within the external storage bays – Time for compliance - 8 January 2018. Site subject to routine monitoring.
