4 CURRENT APPEALS/CALLED IN APPLICATIONS

There is currently one appeal lodged with the Planning Inspectorate.

- 1) Appeal reference APP/U1050/W/17/3190838 by Ineos Upstream Ltd under Section 78 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 against non-determination of the application for land adjacent to Bramley Moor Lane, Marsh Lane, S21 5RD.

The Public Inquiry has been scheduled to start on 19 June 2018. No venue has been set for the Inquiry.

There are two appeal that have recently been determined by the Planning Inspectorate. These are:

- 1) Appeal (Reference APP/U1050/W/16/3166227), by Provectus Remediation Limited under Section 78 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 against non-determination of the application for Hilltop Farm, Derby Road, Clay Cross, Chesterfield, Derbyshire.

A decision was received on 5 March 2018. The appeal was dismissed and planning permission was refused for a surface coal mining scheme with restoration to agriculture with nature conservation benefits at Hilltop Farm, Clay Cross.

- 2) Appeal (Reference APP/U1050/W/17/3179448) by P Casey Enviro Ltd for the refusal of planning application CM1/1115/117 for the extraction and removal of mineral reserves at Arden Quarry, Oven Hill Road, Birch Vale, Derbyshire.

A decision was received on 15 March 2018. The appeal was allowed and planning permission granted subject to conditions for the extraction and removal of mineral reserves at Arden Quarry, Birch Vale.
