

**THE DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(MOOR LANE, CHURCH LANE and QUILOW LANE,**  
**OSMASTON)**  
**(30MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that, on 16th May 2019 Derbyshire County Council pursuant to Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 made an Order with the above title ("the Order").

The Order comes into force on 22nd May 2019. It generally prohibits any person from driving a vehicle at speeds exceeding 30 miles per hour along the following lengths of road:-

**LENGTHS OF ROAD:**

**30 MPH SPEED LIMIT**

**Moor Lane, Church Lane & Quilow Lane, Osmaston**

Moor Lane: From its junction with Quilow Lane to a point 287m north-west of its junction with Church Lane.

Church Lane: From its junction with Moor Lane for a distance of 188m.

Quilow Lane: From the end of Moor Lane for a distance of 29m.

All speed Limit Orders will be revoked insofar as they relate to Moor Lane, Church Lane & Quilow Lane, Osmaston.

A copy of the order, a statement setting out the reasons why the authority proposed to make the order and a plan showing the lengths of road concerned, are available for inspection at the County Council's principal offices known as County Hall on Smedley Street in Matlock between 9 am and 5 pm on each day from Monday to Friday until 6 weeks after the Order is made and at Ashbourne Library, Compton Street, Ashbourne, Derbyshire, DE6 1DA between 9am and 5pm (Mon / Wed / Thurs) between 9am and 7pm (Tues and Fri) and between 9am and 1pm on Saturday until 2nd July 2019.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order, or any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the ground that a requirement of that Act or any relevant regulation made under it has not been complied with may, within 6 weeks from 16<sup>th</sup> May 2019 make application for the purpose to the High Court.
