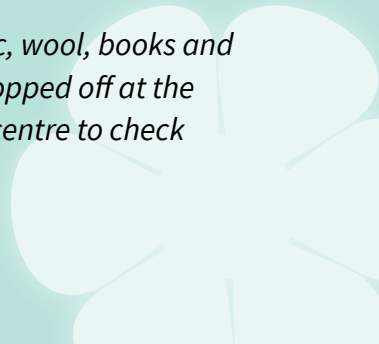
## Board Games play and exchange
