14-19 Part Time **Study Programme** Countywide

Part time learning to suit you in your local Adult **Community Education** Centre, with adults and in small groups of young people. Choose from a wide range of courses, join activities and develop your confidence.

> 16-19 Full Time **Study Programme**

Clay Cross, Shirebrook, Glossop, Cotmanhay, Long **Eaton and Alfreton**

Full time study with other young people to include confidence building, maths, English, IT, personal development and vocational qualifications. You will take part in activities and projects to develop skills for work and go on a work placement.

16-19 Apprenticeship 12 - 24 months Countywide
