2. With your encouragement I don't give up straightaway when I'm trying something new or difficult or when I'm working something out.

3. I show pride when I achieve what I set out to do and when I learn something new. (It doesn't matter if it isn't perfect as I'm still learning.)

4. When I make a mistake or get something wrong I have a 'can do' attitude and keep on trying.

5. I have my own ideas of what to do — I want to find out how things work, try new toys and new ways of doing things. I can get bored with toys or things I'm very familiar with.
