Listening

Listen to instructions and other people.



Think about.....

- What can the child do now?
- What are the next skills needed?
- Make a plan to help.
- Get inspired, talk to others and share ideas.
- Carry out the plan. Keep practising. It may take some time but it's worth it.

1. I can show listening by looking towards the sounds/person. I can stop when the noise stops e.g. musical bumps.

2. I can take turns in simple games with an adult. I show understanding of "wait".

3. I can listen to simple instructions when you use my name first.

4. I can listen to important words and instructions in a game e.g. easy Simon says. I can check I heard you right e.g. ask you to say it again.

5. I can listen to stories and songs and remember the order of words. I notice when you miss bits out.

6. I can stop what I am doing, listen and follow simple instructions*.
