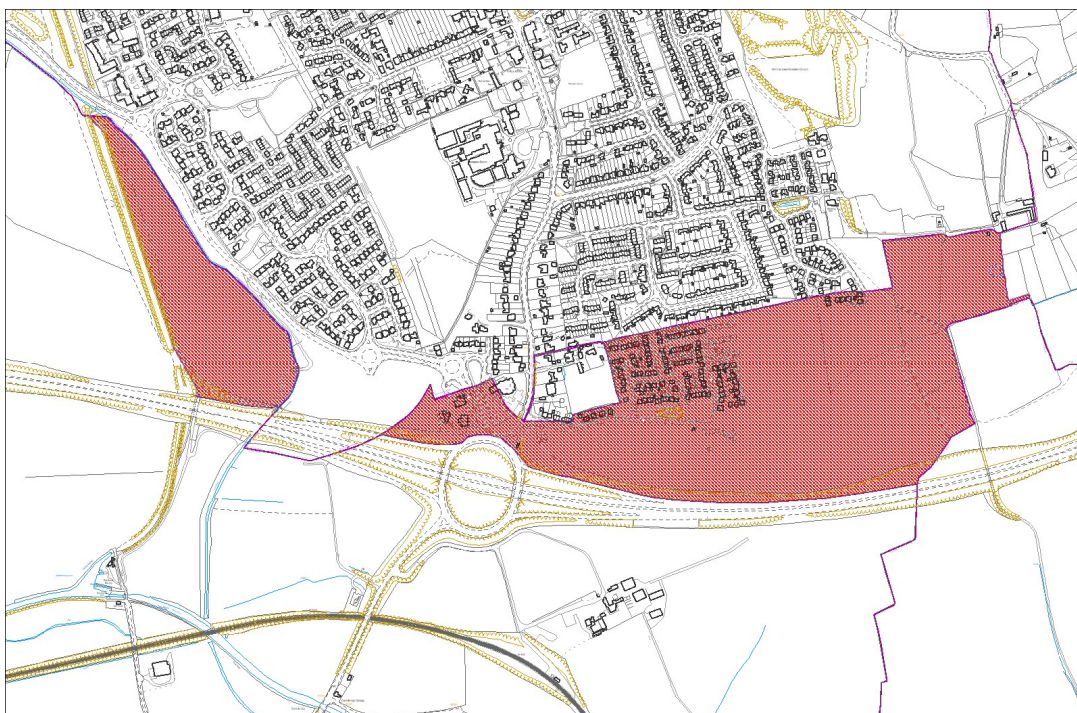
Proposed Amendments to Normal Area

Two new free schools are due to open in September 2019 at Chellaston Fields and Hilton. They will have their own normal areas and serve the housing development within which they are located.

Establishment of a normal area for Chellaston Fields Spencer Academy and reduction of the normal area for Sale and Davys CE (Controlled) Primary School

A new free school, Chellaston Fields Spencer Academy, is currently under construction to serve the Chellaston Fields and Holmleigh residential developments. The developments are currently within the normal area of Sale and Davys CE (Controlled) Primary School. A new normal area is proposed to serve Chellaston Fields Spencer Academy. The attached map shows the area that will become Chellaston Fields and which will be removed from Sale and Davys CE (Controlled) Primary School normal area.

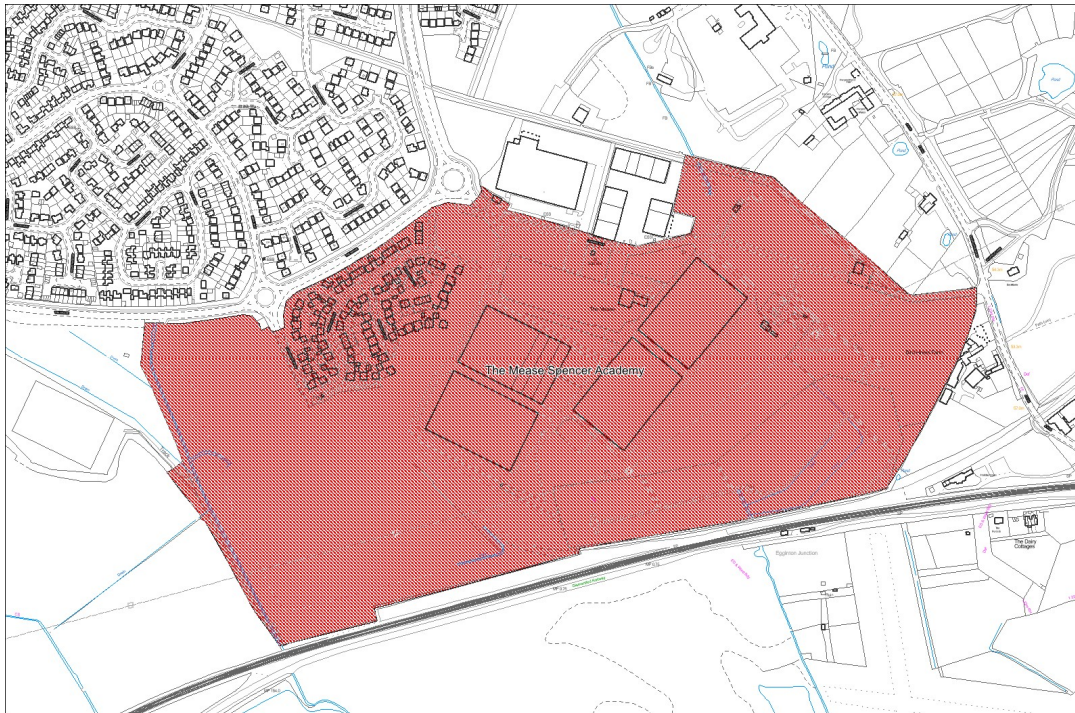

Creation of a temporary shared normal area for The Mease Spencer Academy/Hilton Primary School

A new free school, The Mease Spencer Academy, is currently under construction to serve The Mease residential development. The development is currently within the normal area of Hilton Primary School. It is proposed that the new academy will have a shared normal area with the existing Hilton Primary School. The Mease Spencer Academy is due to open in September 2019 but the new arrangements are proposed from 2020 to ensure that provision is available if the delivery of the school is delayed. Co-ordinated admissions arrangements will be in place from 2020.

Response to major development at Drakelow Park – reduction to normal area of The William Allitt School

Admissions arrangements have already been determined at primary level. At secondary level the normal area of William Allitt will be amended to remove land containing the Drakelow Park development. The area is being included in Staffordshire County Council's Proposed Admission Arrangements for Community and Voluntary Controlled Schools for the Academic Year 2020/21 to bring the development into the normal area of Paulet High School.
