



## Admissions

### To apply for a place

Children due to start in the academic year 2021-2022

Date of birth: - 1st September 2016 to 31st August 2017

The Local Authority is required to co-ordinate admissions to all Derbyshire Primary, Infant and Junior schools for the academic year. Essentially the Authority acts as a 'clearing house' for all admissions and enables parents to express a preference for one, two or three schools and to place those preferences in rank order. Parents must make their application on a common application form, to be returned direct to the LA and give reasons for their preferred schools.

The Green Infant School will continue to follow Derbyshire County Councils admission arrangements for the 21.22 academic year.

If you want to apply to change your child's school at any other time you can find information about how to do this in the changing schools section of the Derbyshire website.

Children who join this school usually transfer from South Normanton Nursery School, South Normanton Pre-School, and Private Nurseries. In order to facilitate as smooth a transfer as possible, children joining The Green Infants are invited for a series of visits in the Summer term before joining us in the September. Parents are invited to a New Parents meeting during the term prior to their child joining the school. This provides an opportunity to hear more about the school, ask questions and meet future class teachers and receive a Welcome Pack. Parents who move into the area are welcome to visit in order to view the school and discuss details.

The Junior School to which the children normally transfer is Glebe Junior School or Leys Junior School. We have good links with the schools and have a comprehensive transition programme during the year that ensures that the Y2 children are happy and confident about the next step in their school life.
