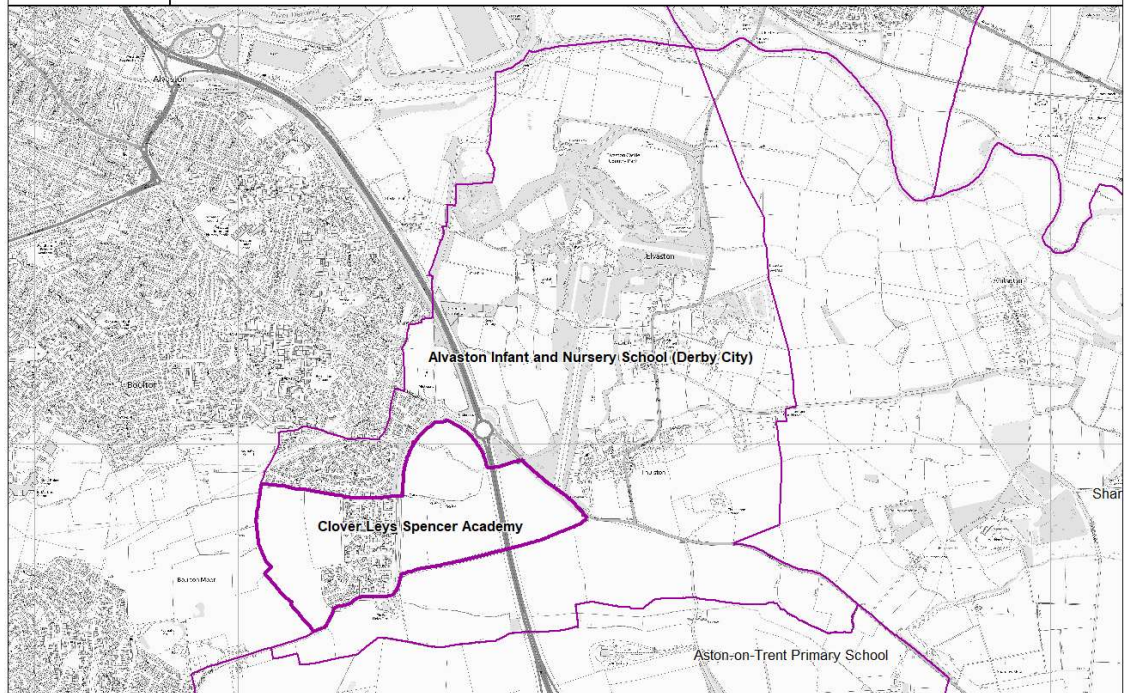

Proposed Amendments to Normal Areas

Establishment of a normal area for Clover Leys Spencer Academy

A new free school, Clover Leys Spencer Academy, is currently in development to serve Phases 1 and 2 of the Boulton Moor residential development. The site for the new school is located within the primary normal areas of Alvaston Infant and Nursery School and Alvaston Junior School, which are Derby City schools. The area, whilst in Derbyshire, is not currently served by a Derbyshire primary school. A new normal area is proposed to serve Clover Leys Spencer Academy. It is anticipated that the area will either be removed from the Derby Schools' normal area or a shared normal area will result. At secondary level the development will be served by Noel Baker Academy, a school within Derby City.

Clover Leys Spencer Academy is due to open in September 2021 but the new arrangements are proposed from 2022 to ensure that provision is available if the delivery of the school is delayed. Co-ordinated admissions arrangements will be in place from 2022.
