The site has been considered against Local, Regional and National planning policy and it has been assessed that the site is constrained by: - Countryside policy (EV1) in the South Derbyshire Local Plan 1998. There are also two Tree Preservation Orders on the site.

#### Summary

The site is a green field site currently used as agricultural land which is located to the west of Church Broughton. The site has potential access to Tipper's Lane and Church Road. We have estimated a site capacity of 43 dwellings. There is no developer interest on the site.

The site is considered to be potentially suitable as it is currently restricted by local planning policy as the site is in an area protected by countryside policy.

The site is considered available as the existing use would not need to be relocated and the site is in one ownership.

The site is considered achievable as it is a green field site and there is a reasonable prospect that the site will be financially viable for residential development in the future. However, the impact on viability of the power supply line across the site may need further assessment.
