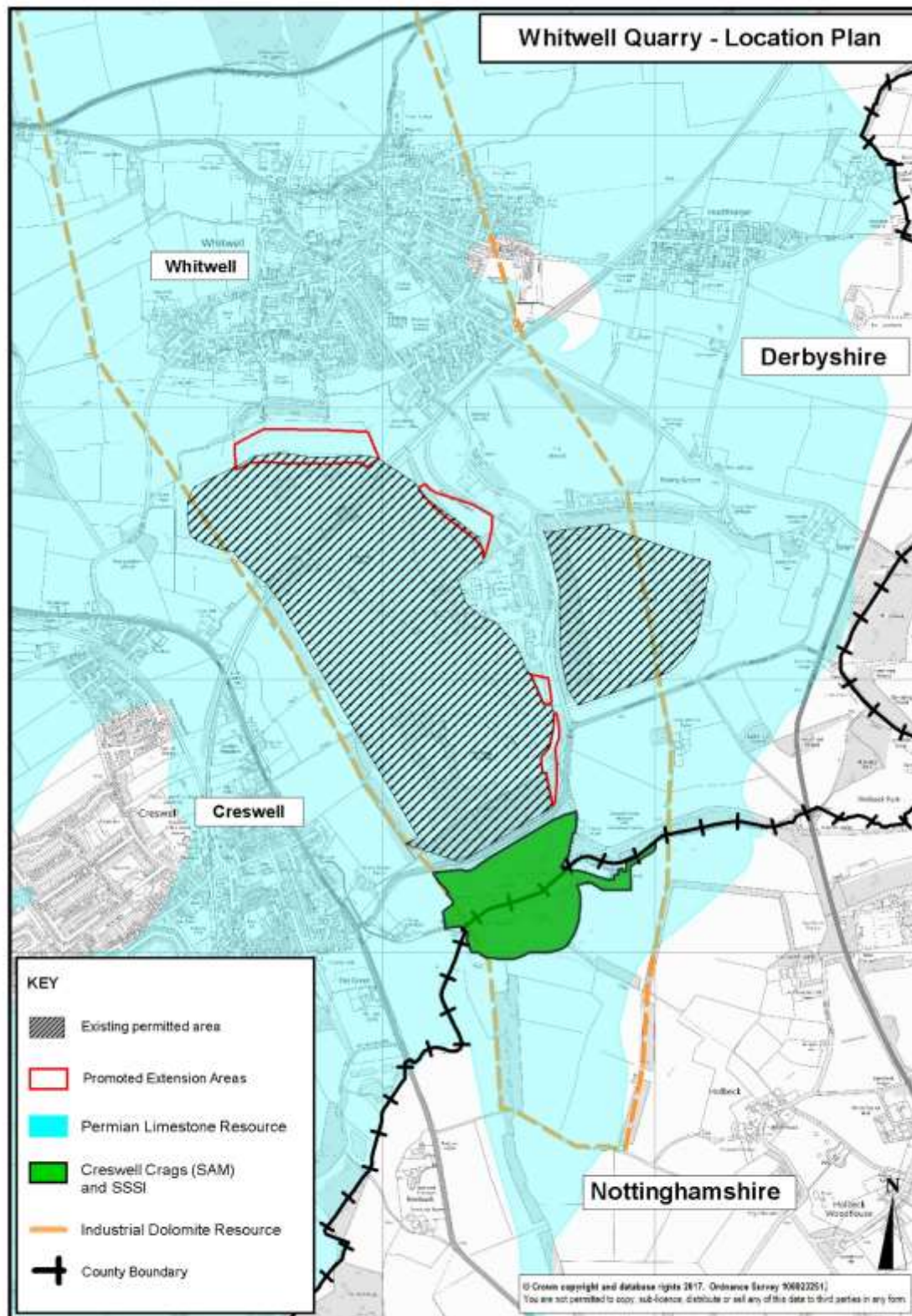

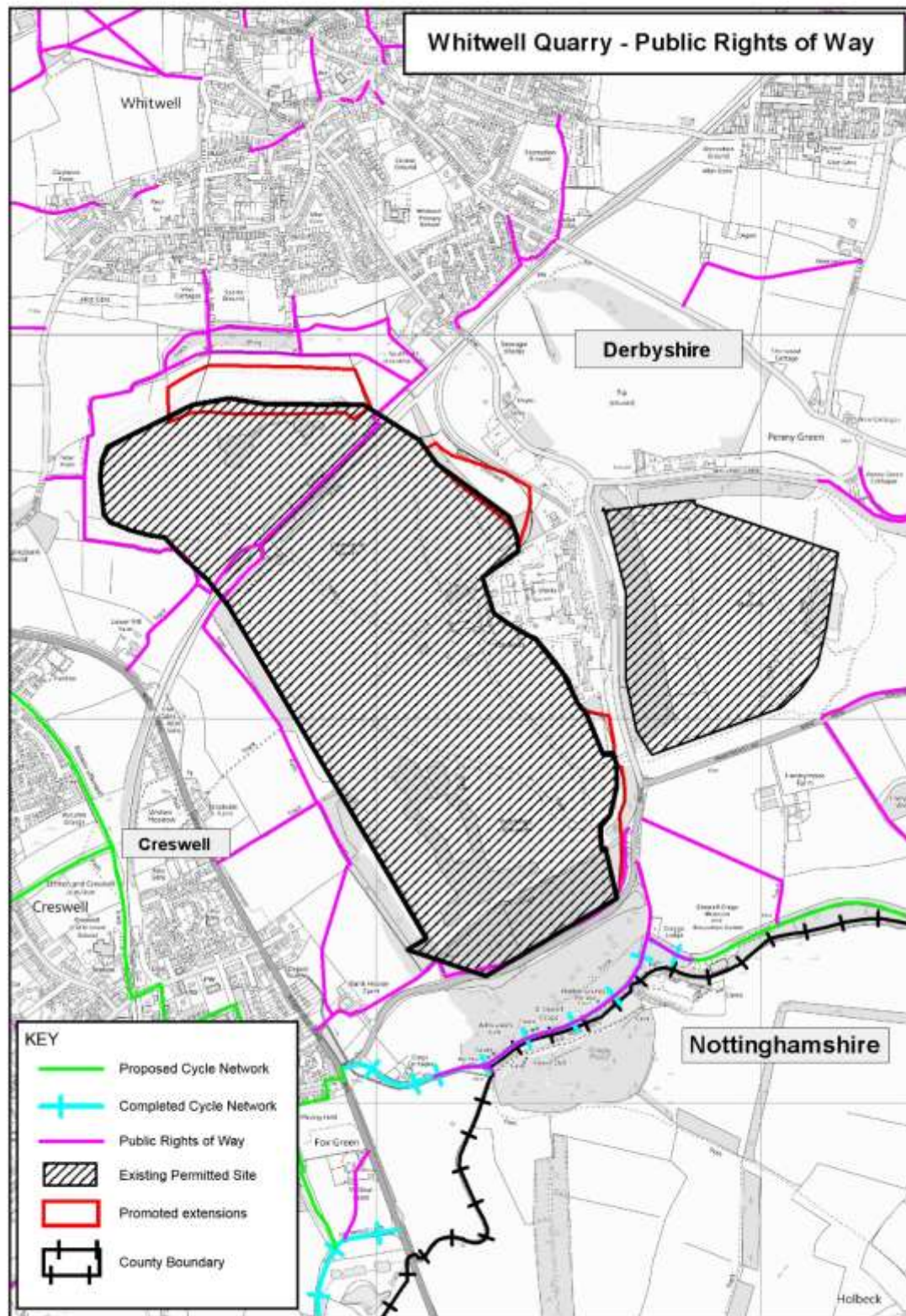

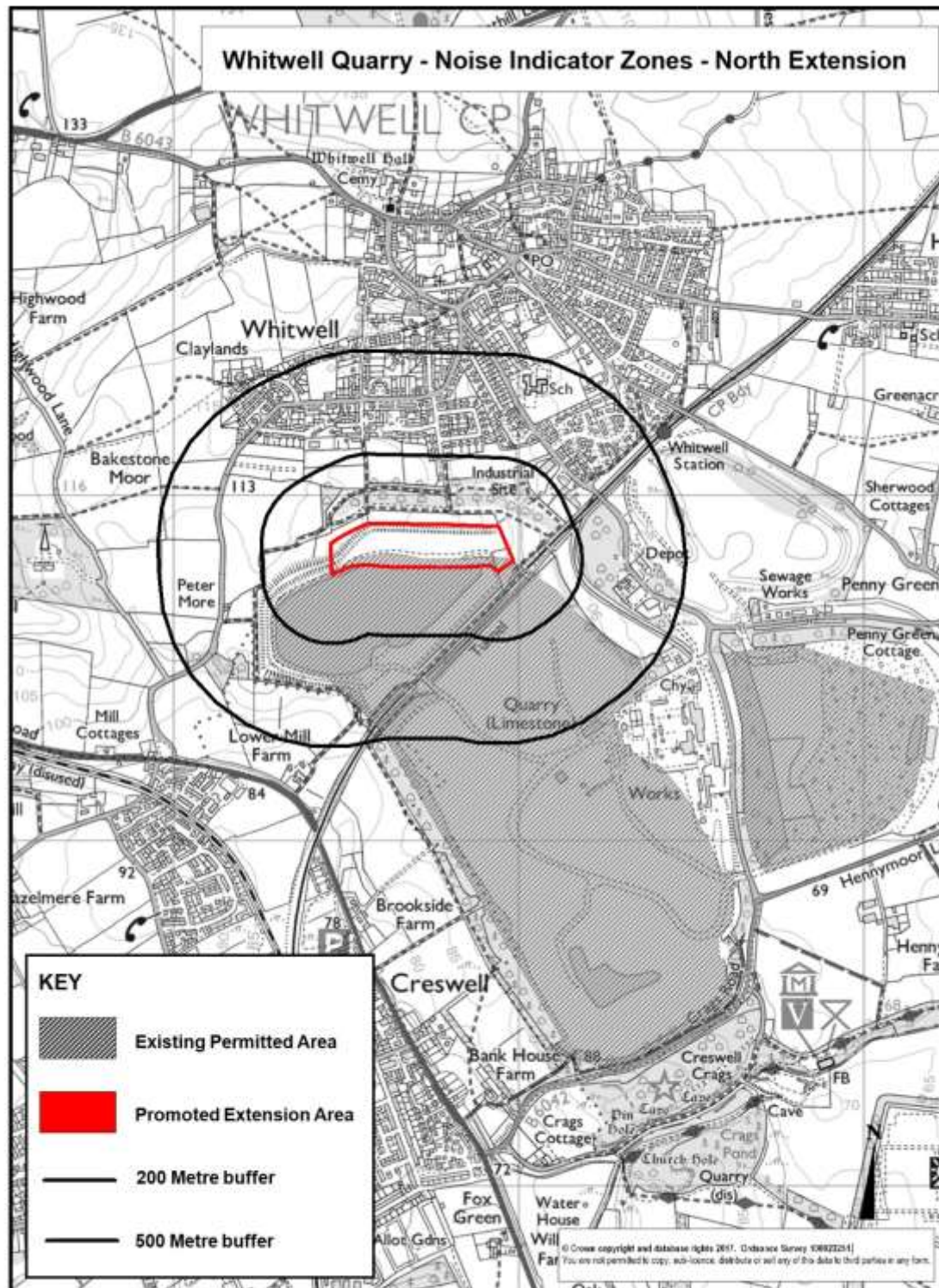


Map 2: Public Rights of Way

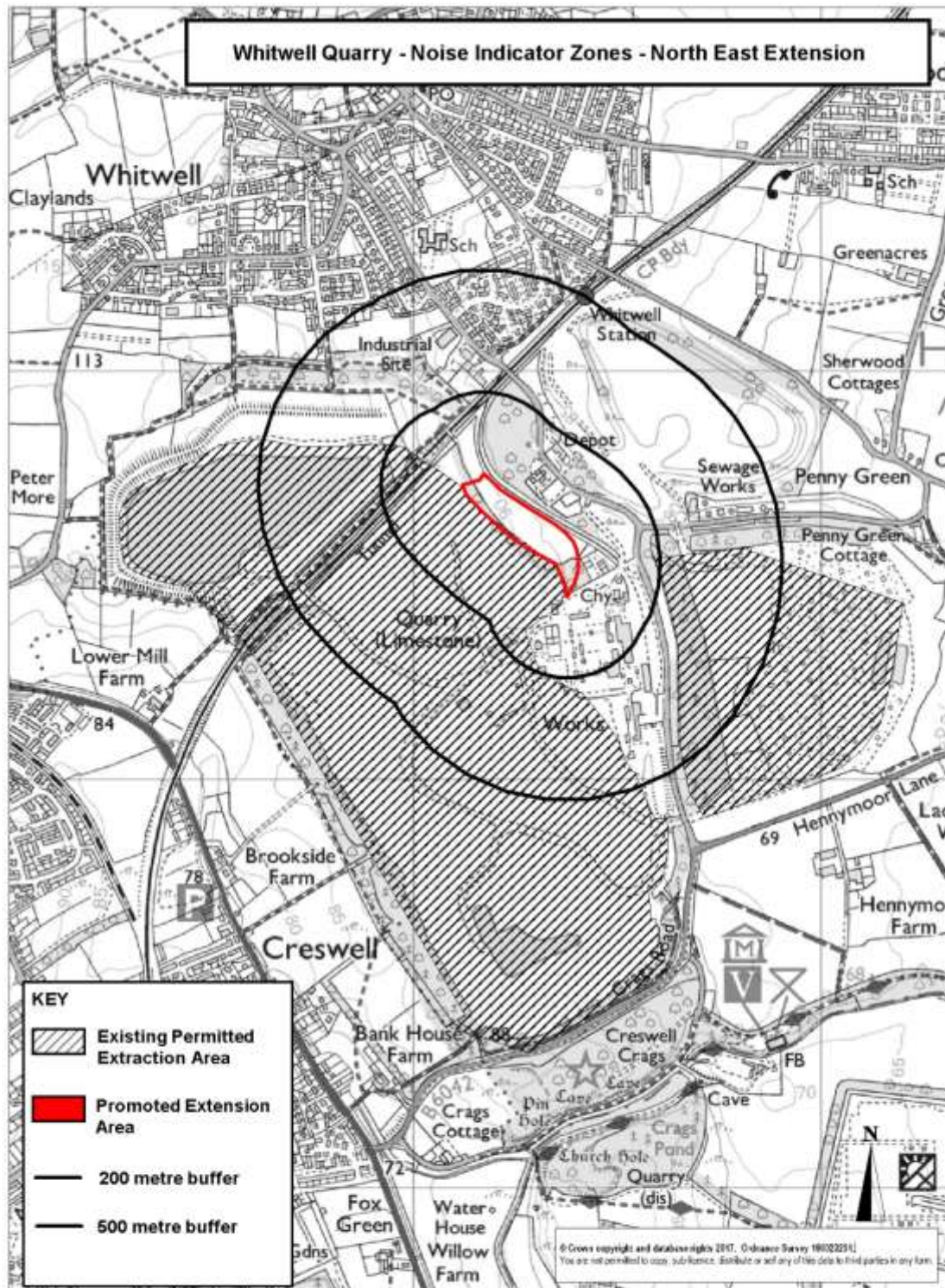
Map 3a– Noise Indicator Zones – North Extension

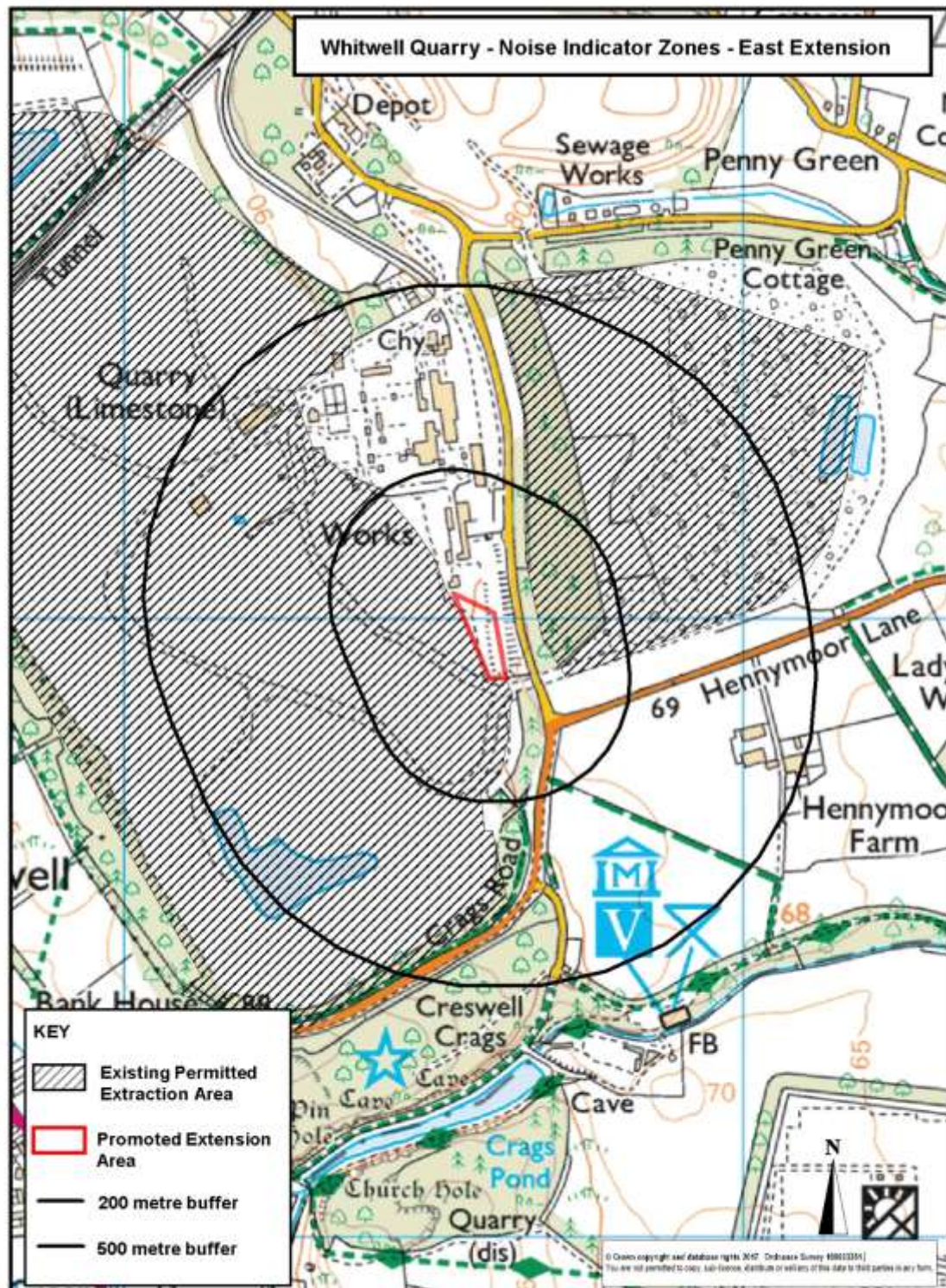


Map 3b– Noise Indicator Zones – North East Extension



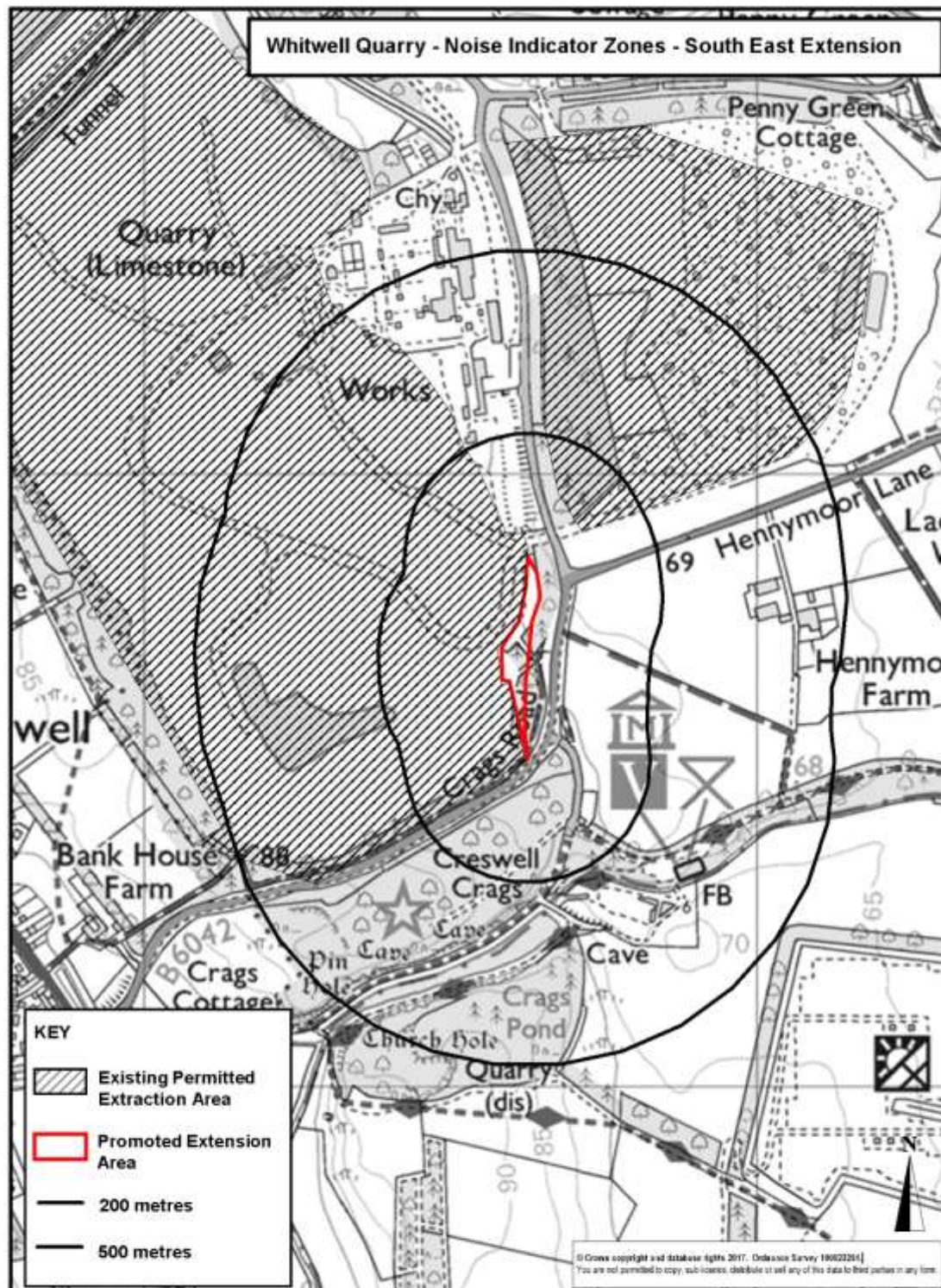


Map 3c– Noise Indicator Zones – East Extension



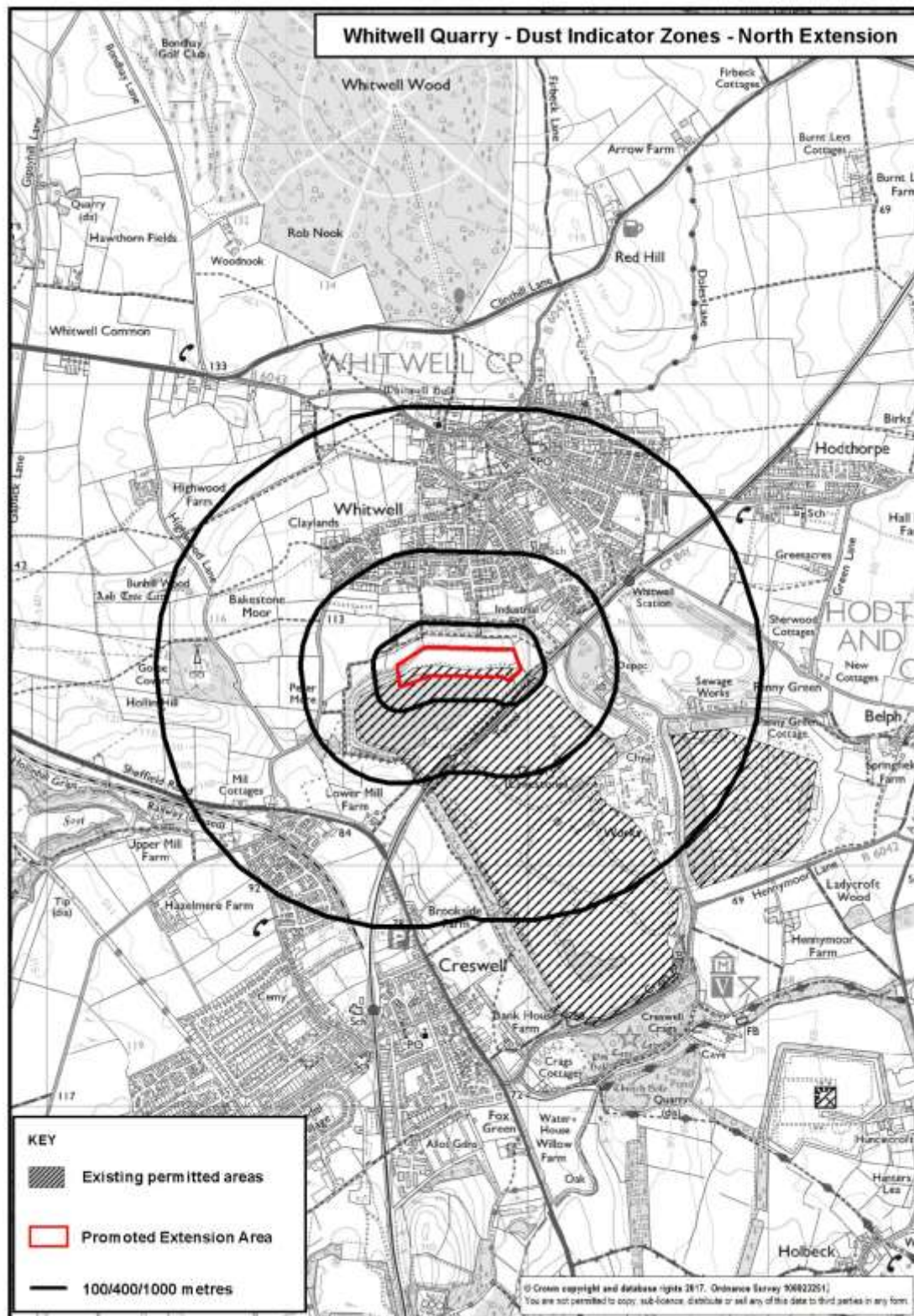


Map 3d– Noise Indicator Zones – South East Extension



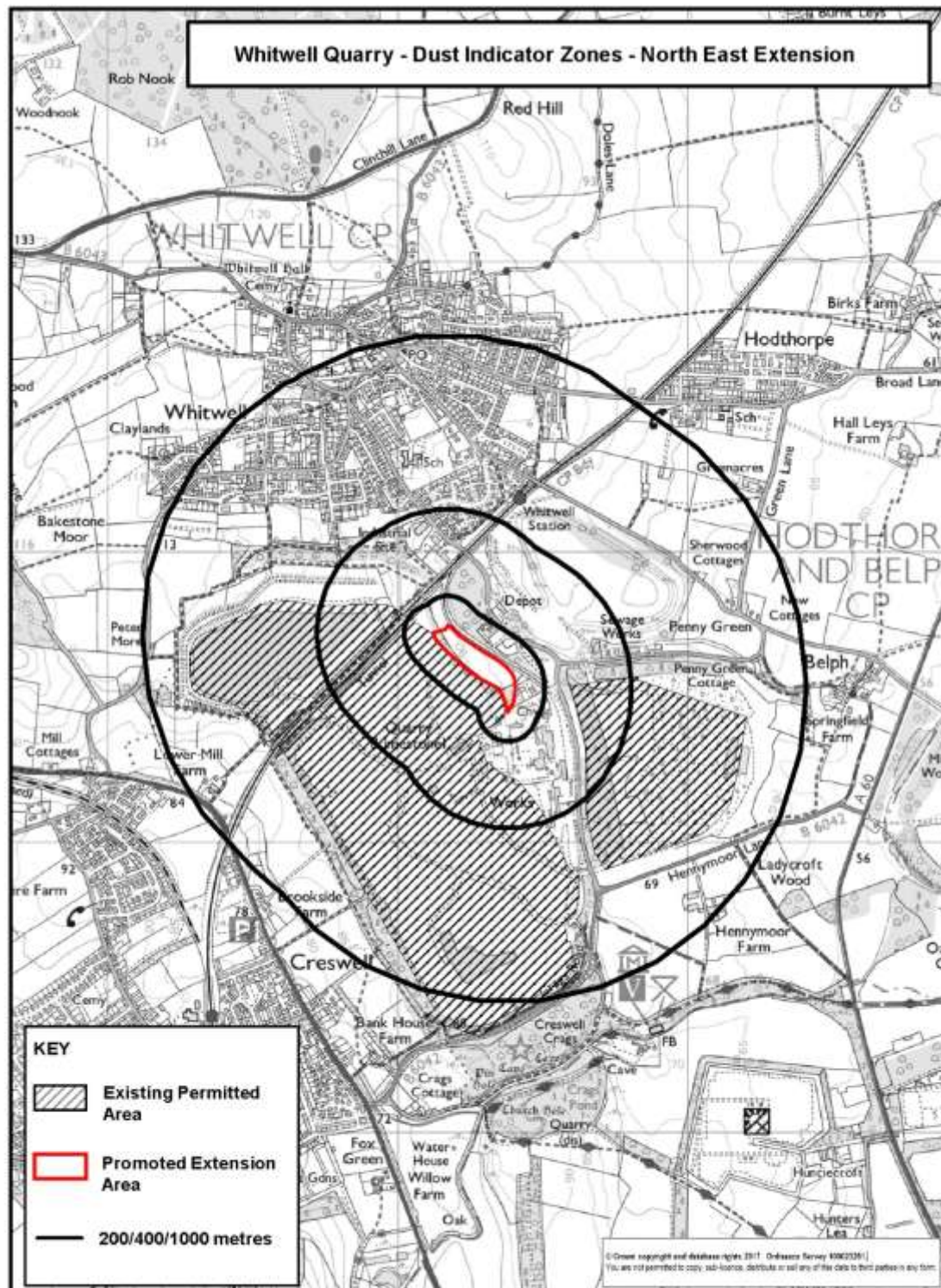


Map 4a– Dust Indicator Zones – North Extension



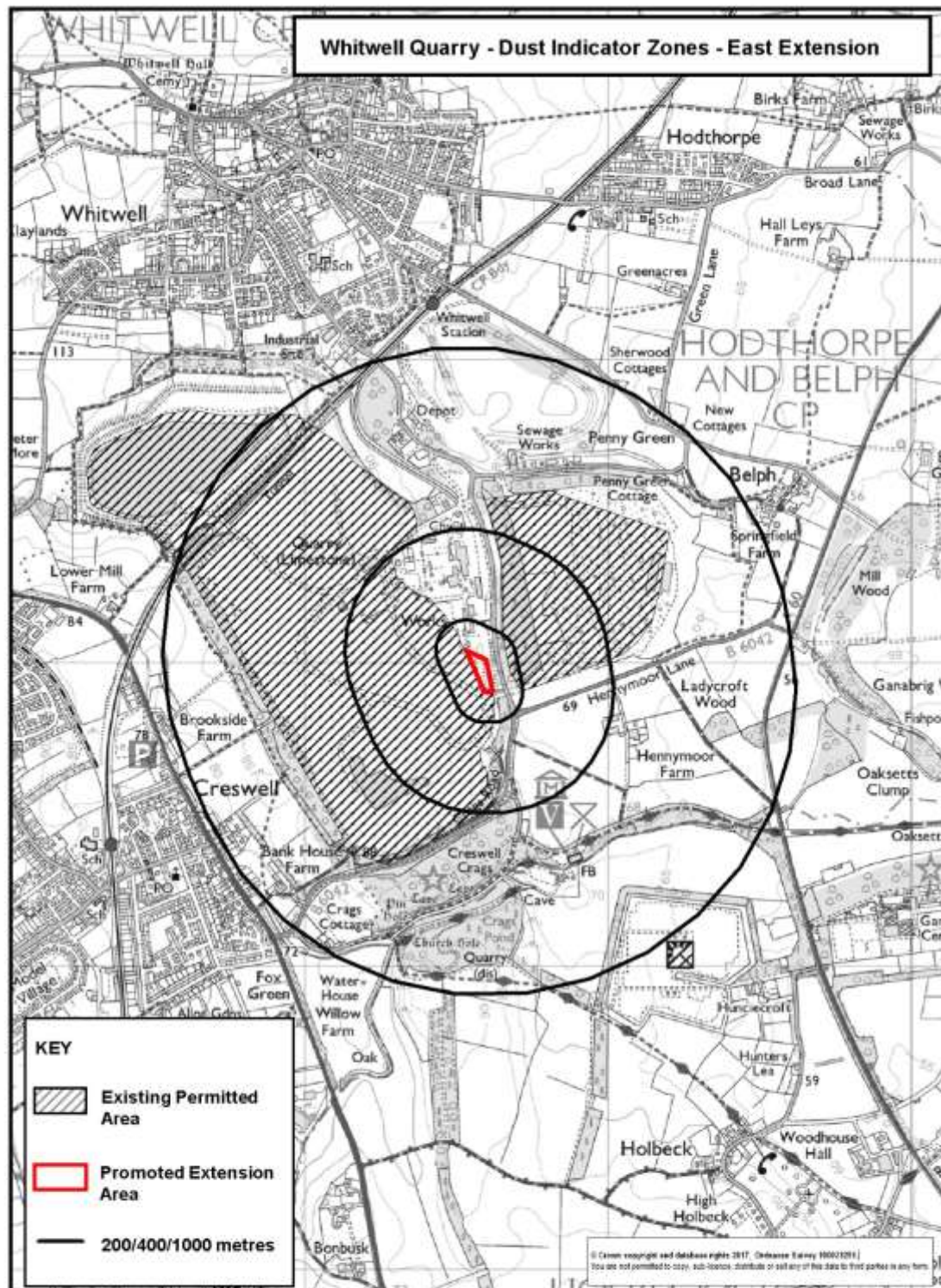

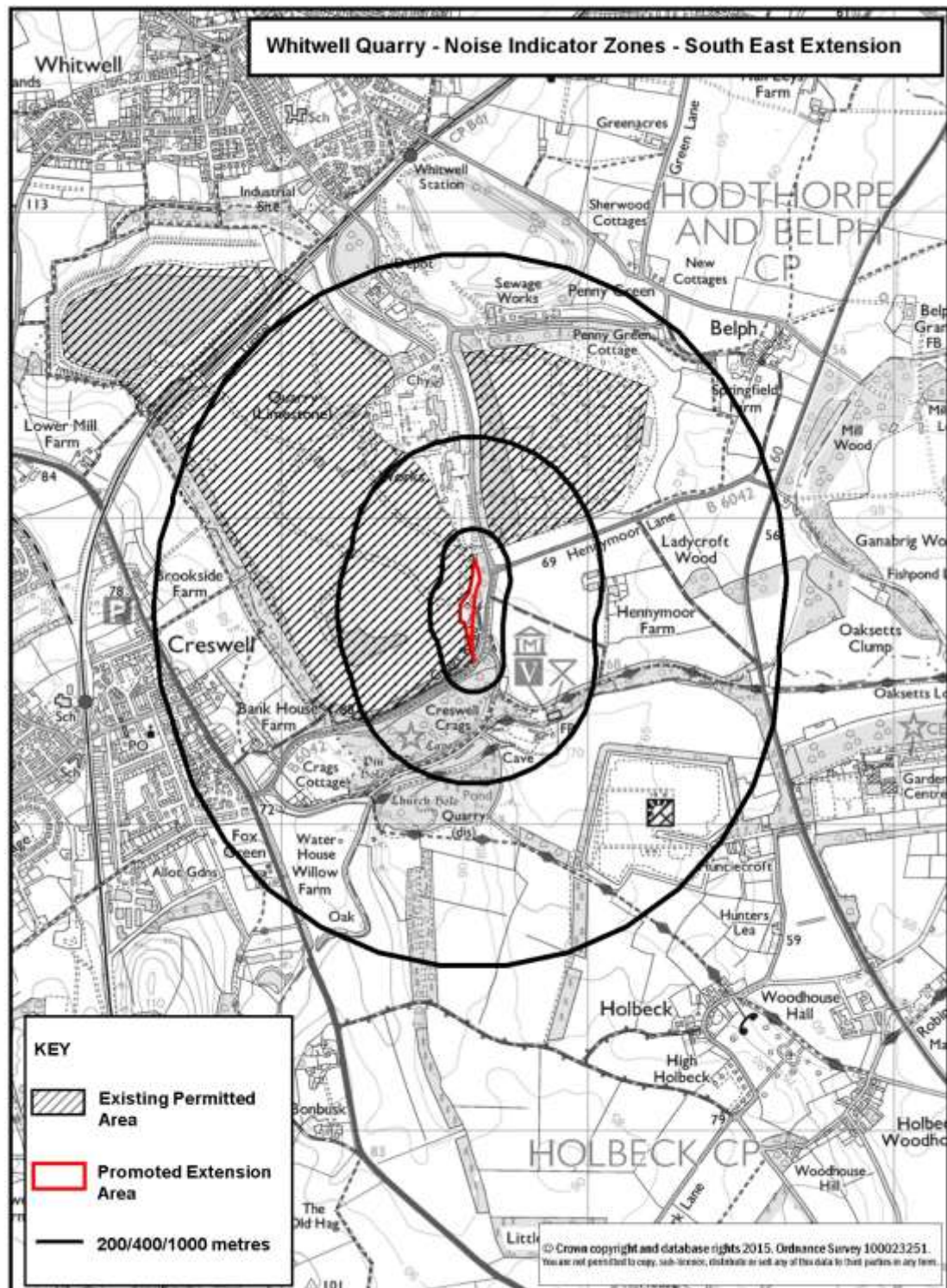




Map 4c– Dust Indicator Zones – East Extension



Map 4d– Dust Indicator Zones – South East Extension



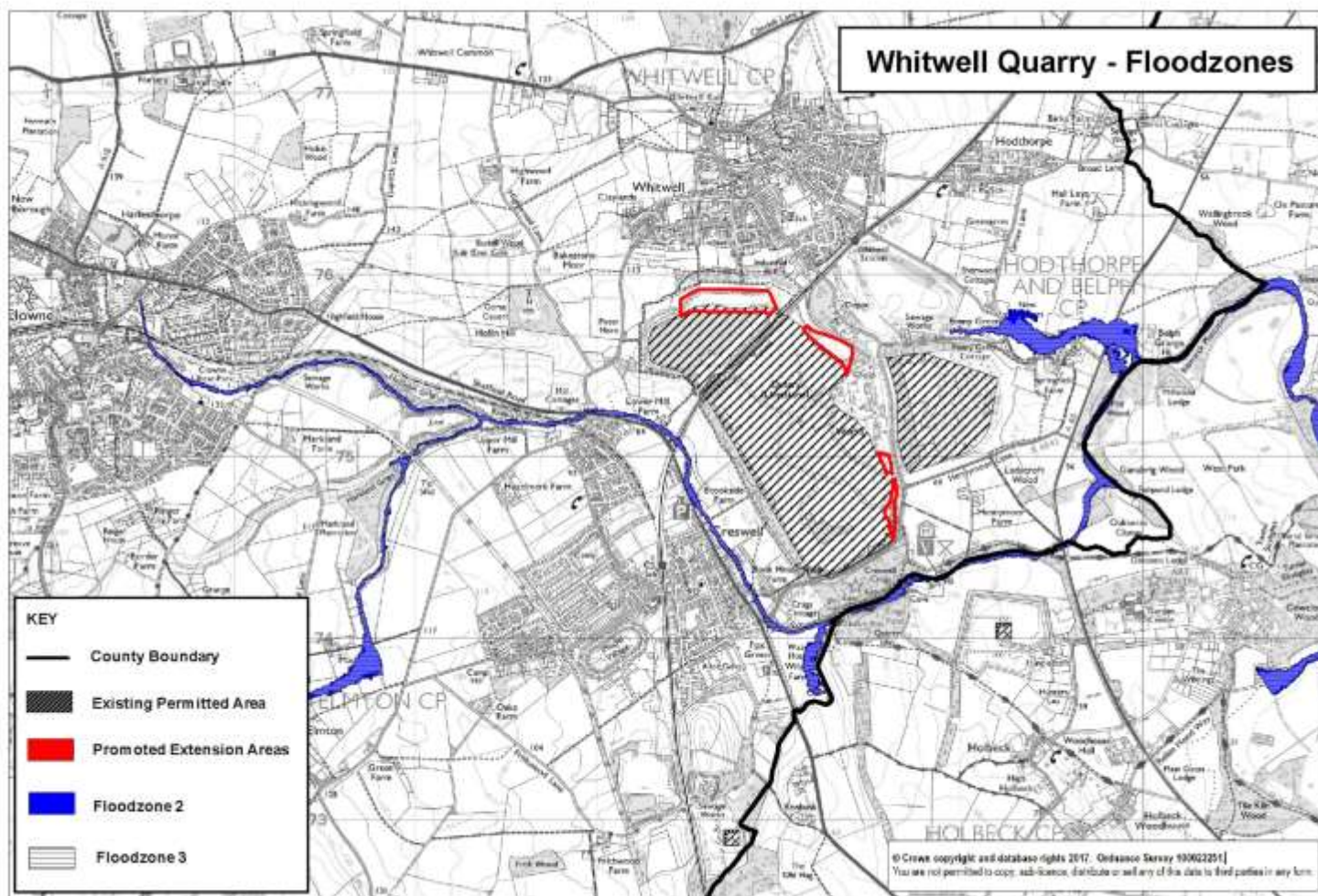

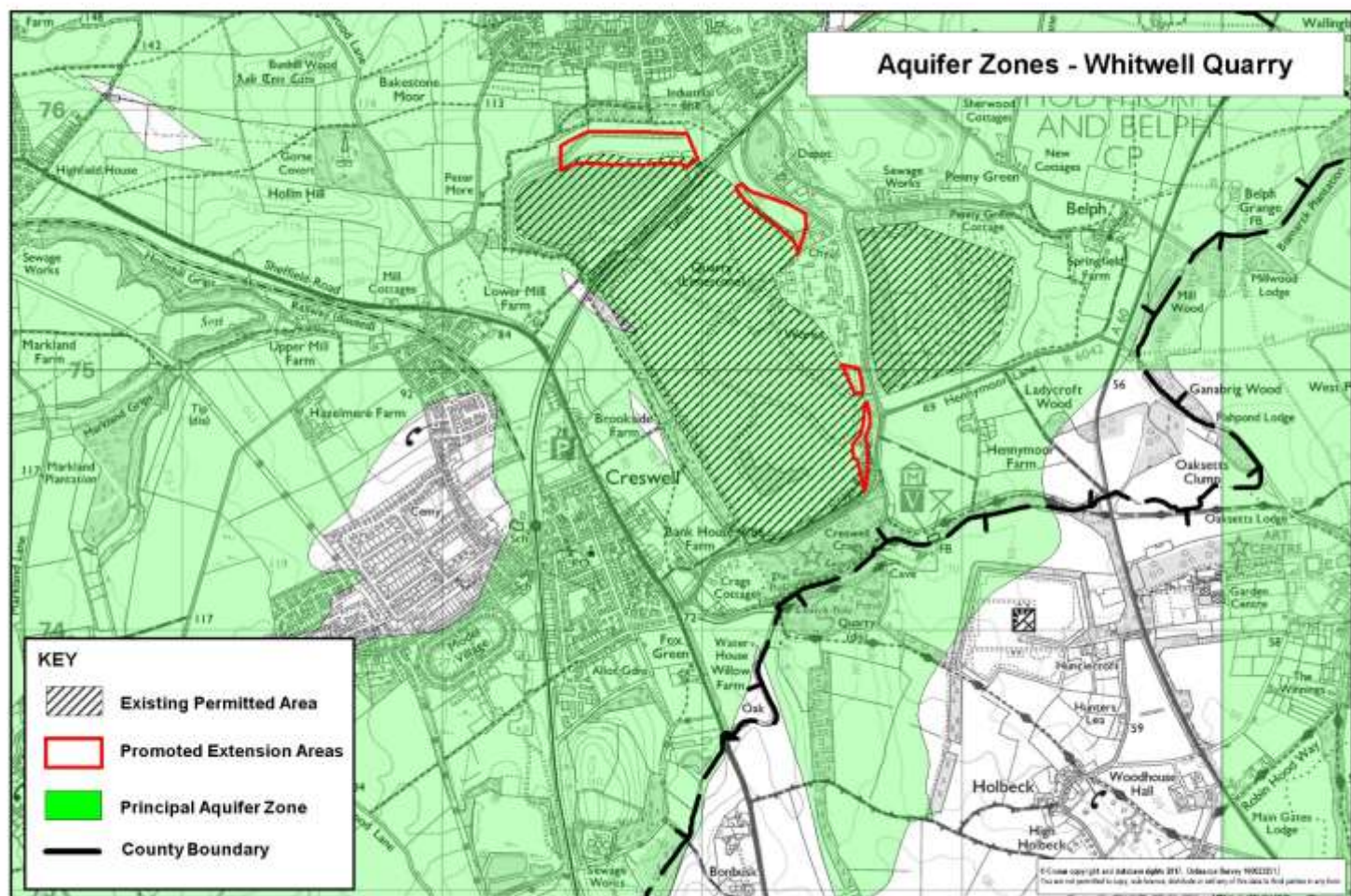


Map 6: Flood Zones and Groundwater Source Protection Zones

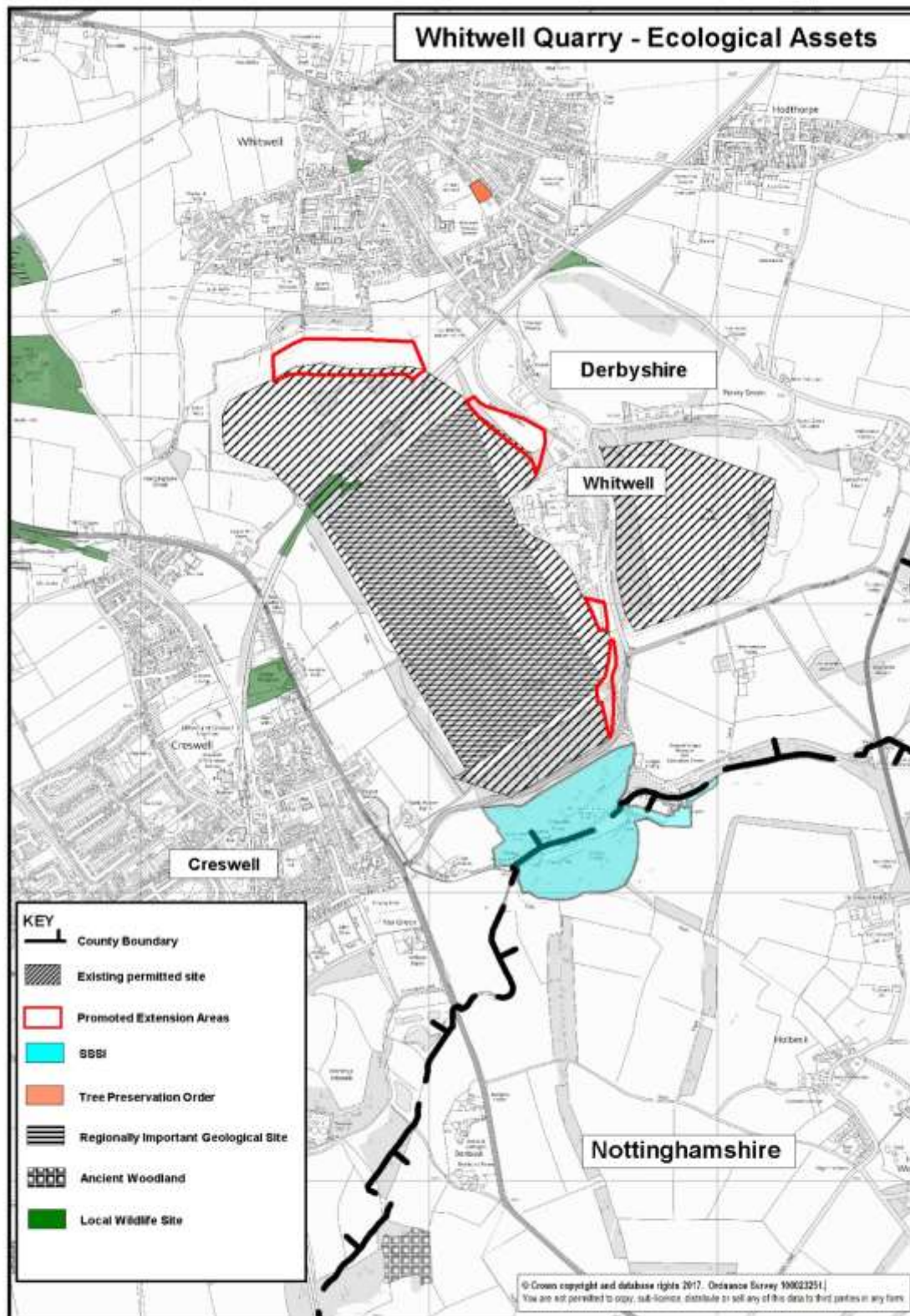
Map 7: Important Aquifer Zones

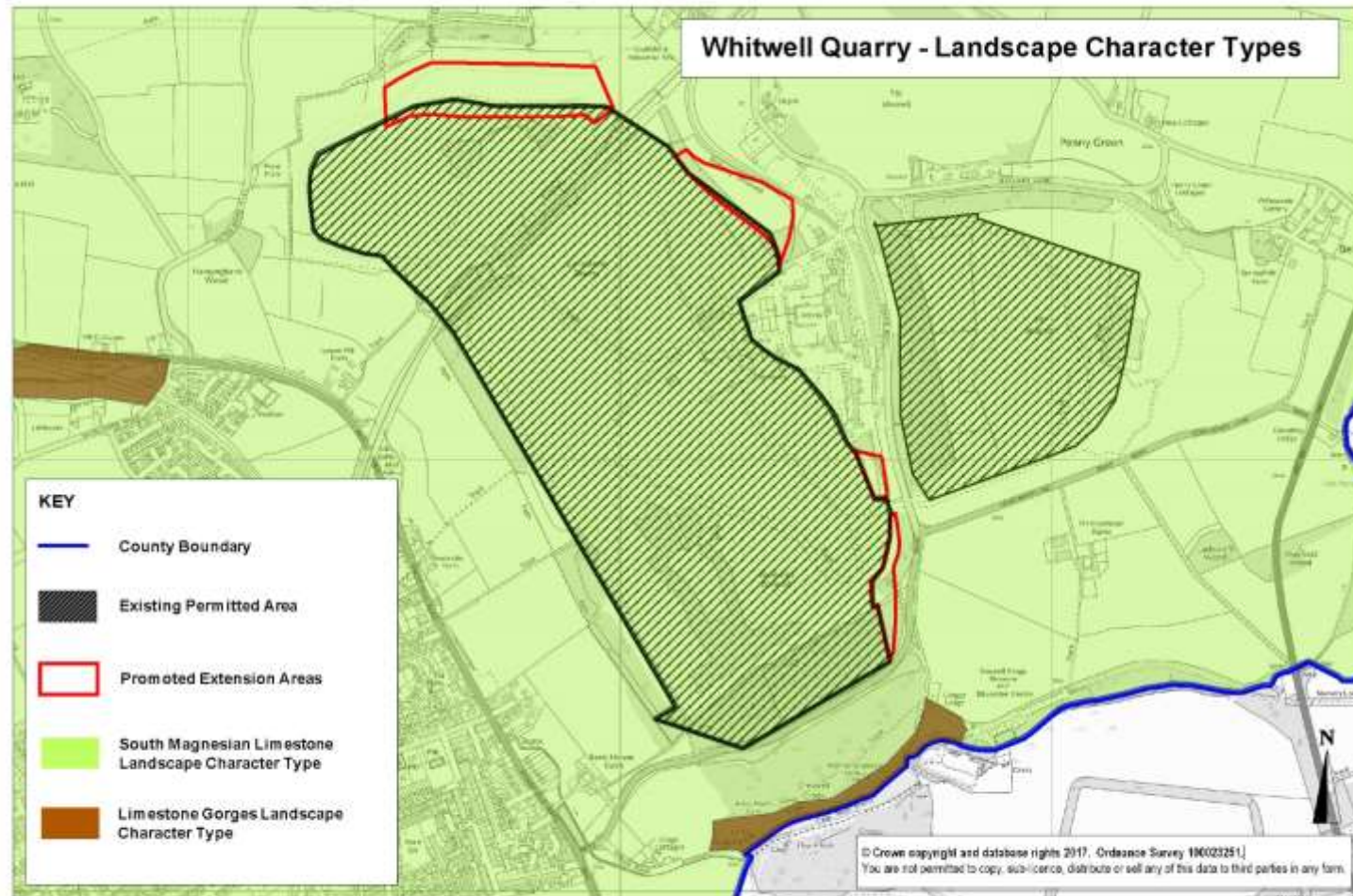


Map 8: Ecological Assets

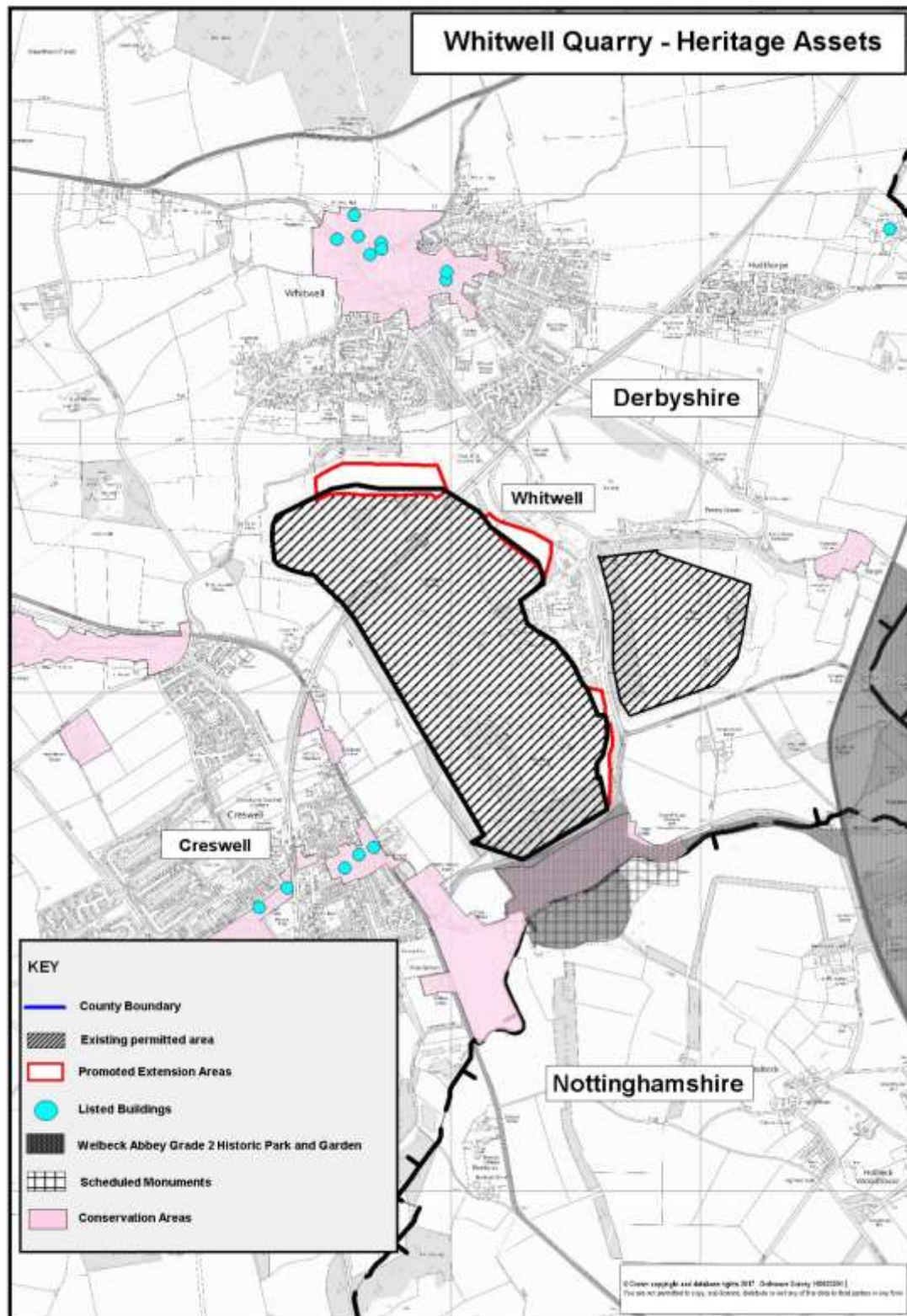
Map 9: Landscape Character Areas

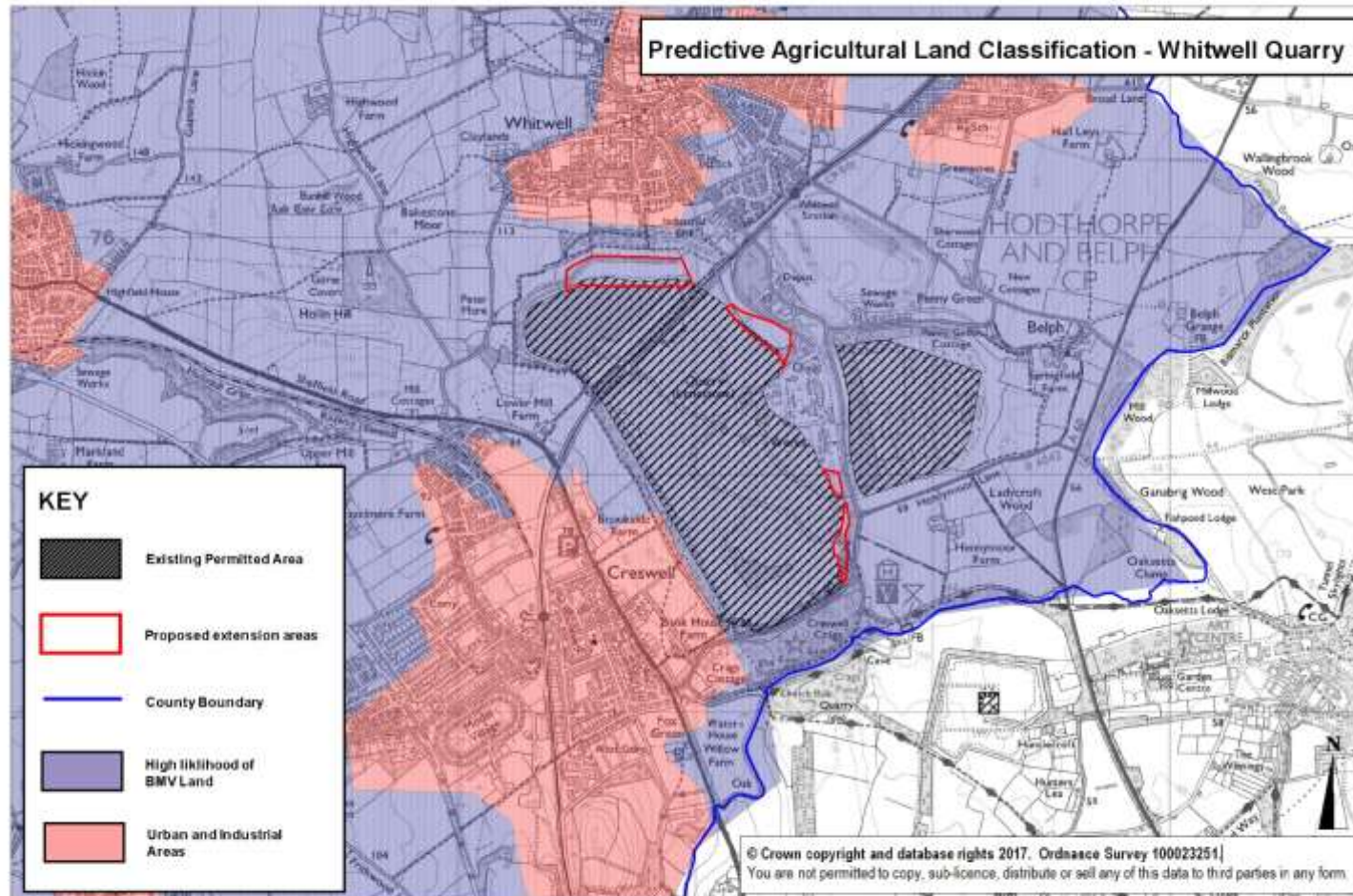


Map 10: Heritage Assets
