## Thinking of using real nappies?

Time for a Change is Derbyshire's real nappy campaign, providing new parents and carers with help and advice on reusable nappies.

Today's nappies come in a variety of fabrics and come in different sizes or "birth to potty" nappies which are adjustable to fit from birth to toddler.

They are easy to use - gone are the days of struggling with folding and safety pins.

They come with easy to use fastenings or poppers and come in a wide choice of colourful, fun designs.

Use them with a liner inside to keep your baby dry.

You can choose from biodegradable liners that can be flushed away or reusable liners that can be washed and used again.

To prevent leaks all real nappies have a breathable waterproof cover. This can either be built in or come separately depending on your nappy choice.



## Go green

Not only is it cheaper but it is also greener to go real.

Eight million disposable nappies are thrown away every day in the UK and most of them go to landfill.

In Derbyshire it is estimated that around 12,000 tonnes of nappy waste is disposed of every year, costing the council over £800,000 in disposal costs.

You can cut your household rubbish by up to half and help the environment by choosing real nappies.

Make your real nappies even greener by following the top tips below:

- ❖ Wash nappies and wraps between 40C and 60C - do not boil wash
- ❖ Use A-rated appliances to reduce energy and water use
- ❖ Hang nappies out to dry or use an ailer - don't use your tumble dryer
- ❖ Don't use fabric conditioner as it will reduce the nappy's absorbency
- ❖ Use eco-friendly washing powders
- ❖ Use real nappies for more than one child
- ❖ Buy second hand nappies where possible
- ❖ Use organic (non-bleached) products
- ❖ Don't iron nappies



## Save money

One of the many benefits of using real nappies is that they can save you money.

The total cost of using real nappies can be less than half that of using throw away ones.



By the time your baby is potty trained you could have used between 4,000 to 6,000 disposable nappies.

By comparison you only need between 15 to 24 real nappies - saving you up to £1,000 depending on the type of nappy you choose.

Further savings can be made by using the same real nappies for another child.

There is no need to soak or pre-wash nappies, just wash them at 40 - 60 degrees celsius with a non-biological detergent.

Nappy retailers suggest using half the recommended amount of washing powder as too much can cause a build up in the nappies.

To keep nappies extra fresh, you can use an anti-bacterial nappy cleanser such as tea tree oil or nappy sanitiser in your wash.
