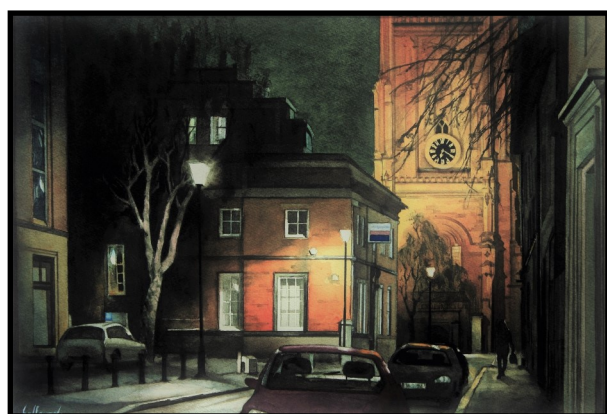




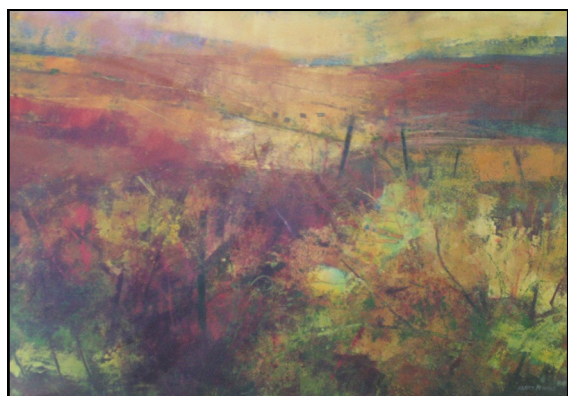

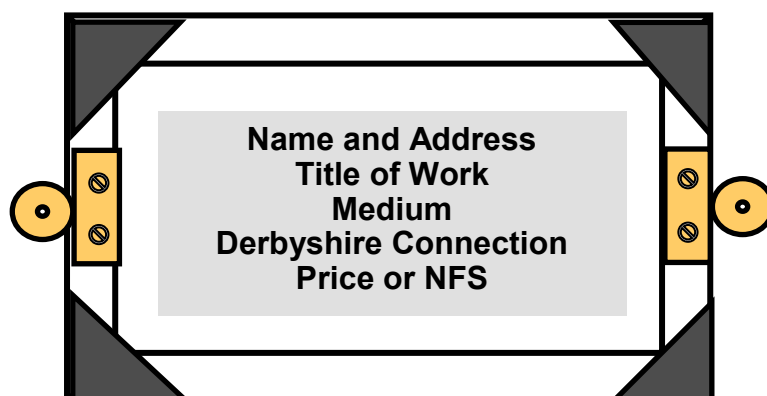
Artwork will be accepted at Buxton Museum and Art Gallery on the above dates. Early or late entries will not be accepted. You will be given a receipt which you must retain. This will record the number(s) of your work(s). **If you do not have email, please bring a 1st class stamped addressed envelope with your work.**

Judging

Four independent judges will select work and award prizes. Their decision is final. We will send the list of accepted work to all entrants by email. The list will be published on the website by 5pm on **Thursday 18th June**.

Entry Guidelines

1. The competition is open to all artists, professional and amateur, submitting work showing what is special about Derbyshire. This could be landscape, townscape, residents, local myths, still life or something else. Tell us on the entry form how the work illustrates this.
2. All submitted artworks must be original works of art, created in the last 5 years, and must not have been entered for this competition previously.
3. Artists may submit up to two artworks, either two or three-dimensional, in any medium except photographic prints. Digital manipulation may be used as an element of the original artwork. It will be at the judges' discretion whether to consider the work.
4. 2D work should not exceed 1.5 metres in either dimension. Entries of large or heavy work should be discussed with the museum before the submission dates.
5. Work for sale is subject to 35% commission plus VAT at the current rate. Artists will receive payment by cheque after the end of the exhibition, when all monies from the purchases have been received by Derbyshire County Council.
6. All 2D work must be framed, labelled with the information shown below and fitted with protective corners and mirror plates as shown in the diagram. Clip frames will not be accepted. Please remove all other packing material before handing work in.



7. If it is not possible to attach a label to 3D work, please attach a corded luggage label clearly stating the information as shown above.
8. Please complete the entry form and bring it with you when submitting your artwork/s.
