SECTION 6: Strategic Network Mapping

6.1 Introduction

- 6.1.1 This section of the strategy presents a series of five detailed maps to show the layout and alignments of the proposed Greenway network for the district of South Derbyshire as described in previous sections. The maps show the existing and proposed routes and distinguish between the primary, secondary and tertiary status. Cross boundary connections are also shown to give a visual sense of the intended circuits. Figure 6 shows the overlay positions of the five more detailed route maps to assist quick reference and this is represented on the key of each map to show its relationship within the series.
- 6.1.2 Where relevant to the specific route alignments, the following features and trip generators are also shown;
 - Alternative route alignments
 - Connecting bridleways
 - Major development and restoration sites (including housing and employment allocations and mineral extraction allocations)
 - National Forest Tender Scheme sites
 - Visitor attractions
 - Schools
 - Leisure Centres
 - Public transport interchanges
