

# Conditions of Parking Permit

- 1: The parking permits need to be renewed annually in April.
- 2: Application forms are only available from Clay Cross Countryside Centre.
- 3: Each vehicle is to display a valid parking permit at all times.
- 4: The parking permit and key are for a specific applicant and are not transferable. Please inform us immediately if you lose your key or parking permit.
- 5: These are high security locks and keys must not to be replicated / distributed.
- 6: Parking permit holders must park sensibly so that others can park easily, and access is available to all gates at all times.
- 7: Parking permit holders must ensure **gates are locked** correctly on entry and exit.
- 8: Owners park at their own risk and the County Council will not be held responsible for any damage or losses incurred.
- 9: Parking spaces will be on a first come first serve basis.
- 10: The County Council reserves the right to terminate the agreement / scheme at any time.
- 11: Upon the termination of this agreement any keys and passes should be returned immediately to the Clay Cross Countryside Centre.
- 12: It should be noted that the sites vary in numbers of spaces, size of area, accessibility and charges. It is recommended that a parking location is checked before a visit is made.
- 13: Please only Walking and trotting (no cantering or galloping) on the trails.
- 14: Please show courtesy to pedestrians, cyclists and other riders.

## **Other considerations:**

- It would be helpful if you could let us know if a number of people intend to use the parking at any one time so that we can advise other users if need be.
- Take all rubbish and horse droppings home with you.
- Inform us if you have a problem on site or need to report an incident.
- We would welcome feedback on how the system is working

Tibshelf Ponds	Not Gated at the moment but will be in the future	4	440sq m	Car park is separated into car and horse box parking and shared with the fishing club (to be gated) <b>Reversing may be required</b> <b>Beware</b> approach road has a number of over hanging trees and the unadopted lane often has cars parked making access difficult for lorries. If approaching from Morton beware of low bridge on Station Rd / Doe Hill Lane B6014 height 4.1m (13ft 6inch) (adjacent to Stone broom Lane)
Timber Lane	Not Gated	1	290sq m	This is a very small shared car park with a narrow lane for access and tight parking. Not recommended for lorries, horse box and car only please. <b>Reversing definitely Required</b>
Holmewood Car Park	Gated	6 +	1000sq m	Large shared car park in the centre of the village, with Tarmac surface. <b>Reversing unlikely to be required</b>
Stockley Ponds	Height Barrier & Gate this is to be changed to just a gate in the very near future	6	800sq m	Car park is separated into horse box and car spaces <b>Reversing may be required</b> <b>Warning:</b> there has been some anti social behaviour associated with this car Park in the past
Poulter Country Park	Height Barrier & Gate	2	545sq m	Car park is separated into horse box and car spaces. <b>Reversing required</b> This is and awkward height barrier to unlock and relock a mounting block is recommended.
Peter Fidler	Height Barrier	2	600sq m	Small shared car park <b>Reversing required</b>
Grassmoor Country Park	Height Barrier	2	700sq m	Small car park is separated into horse box and car spaces. Parking is shared with fishing club beyond height barrier <b>Reversing may be required</b> <b>It is recommended that people park adjacent and parallel to the central barrier on both sides.</b>
Westthorpe Hills	Arnco Barrier	8	1200sq m	Larger car park with tarmac surface. Access for Horse box parking only. Turning area at end of car park around small copse of shrubs. <b>Reversing not required. Please do not block the inner gate onto the main site or the access from the road.</b> Small area in front of access gate allows parking whilst opening

				barrier, although trailer may protrude slightly into main road
Renishaw Car Park Trans Pennine Trail	Height Barrier	4	300sq m	Small car park is separated into horse box and car spaces. Reversing not required, either gate may be used to egress / access the parking space. It is recommended that people park adjacent and parallel to the fence or car park edge. Please note that access to the Trans Pennine Trail is off the end of the eastern gate, and care should be taken to avoid users accessing the car park and trail through the bollards.

**These recommendations are based on 7.5 ton medium sized lorry and a horse Box and Land Rover it is strongly recommended that you check the site first before your first visit.**
