

## CHARIED TERRITORY Maps of All Sizes Modern day maps tend to be the same size, use the same symbols and fonts, and give the same type of information. But historically each map was created for its own specific purpose and its size was chosen by the surveyor, according to the demands of their client and



their willingness (or ability) to pay.

This sketch is only 17 cm wide, and was produced to illustrate the land – coloured in green – purchased by the second Jedediah Strutt from William Slater in February 1823.
