A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE REGISTERS OF THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND

When did parish registers begin?

Every parish of the Church of England was required to keep a register of baptisms, marriages and burials by the *Injunctions issued in 1538 by Thomas Cromwell*, chief minister of King Henry VIII, in his capacity as Vicegerent in Spirituals. The Injunctions were repeated at various times in the following sixty years, despite the religious changes, and were eventually reinforced by the Provincial Constitutions of Canterbury issued in 1597 and approved by Queen Elizabeth I in 1598. These required the existing registers, which were usually of paper, to be copied into more durable parchment volumes. Consequently, few of the original paper registers survive. Many of the copies made as a result of the Constitutions of Canterbury in fact only start from 1558 or later, and for some parishes the oldest surviving register begins in the seventeenth or even eighteenth century.

Are they continuous?

For some parishes the registers do not survive in an unbroken series, and there may be some substantial gaps in those of the sixteenth and seventeenth centuries, particularly at the time of the Civil War and Commonwealth (1642-1660) and just after.

Where can I look if registers of a specific parish are incomplete?

If the register for a particular period does not survive, it may be possible to obtain the required information from the *bishop's transcripts* (usually abbreviated to BTs). These are contemporary copies of the registers made by the incumbent of a parish or on his behalf, and sent periodically to the bishop. They were first required by the Constitutions of Canterbury but very occasionally copies for a period earlier than 1597 were also supplied. Survival of BTs for Derbyshire parishes in the period before 1642 is rare and between 1642 and 1660 they are non-existent. Nevertheless for some parishes they pre-date the earliest surviving register. They continued to be made until the practice was discontinued in the mid to late nineteenth century.

Throughout the period in which BTs were made, Derbyshire was in the diocese of Lichfield and Coventry. As a result the bishop's transcripts for the county are kept as part of the Lichfield diocesan archives at the Lichfield Record Office, The Friary, Lichfield, Staffordshire WS13 6QG. A summary guide to what transcripts exist for each parish is to be found in the Guide to the contents of Lichfield Record Office. A copy of this is available for consultation in the Derbyshire Record Office search room.

What do the registers contain?

Parish registers vary in scope and content according to the date at which they were compiled. At first they were concerned in general only to record the name of the person being married or buried, with the names of the parents in addition to that of the child in the case of baptism. Although some incumbents did record more than this information, others did not even provide this much. In the reign of Mary Tudor (1553-58) and occasionally afterwards, baptism entries include the names of the sponsors or godparents. The normal format was to have all types of entry recorded in chronological order, although a few parishes separated baptisms, marriages and burials into different sections of the same register, and, occasionally, into separate volumes.

Are marriage registers different?

The first change in the recording of marriages took place in the mid eighteenth century. *Lord Hardwicke's Marriage Act (1753)*, which came into force in April 1754, required a separate register to be kept for marriages, and a set form of words to be used. Though not a requirement of the Act, most parishes adopted volumes of printed forms. Entries in the new registers had to be signed by both parties to a marriage and by at least two witnesses. The parish or parishes of origin of the two parties were also stated.

The *format of marriage registers was standardised by Rose's Act (1812)*, which made volumes consisting of printed forms obligatory from the 1st January 1813. These continued to follow the Hardwicke Act wording. The next major development in the marriage registers occurred with the advent of *civil registration of births, marriages and deaths in July 1837*. From that time officiating clergymen were obliged to record in addition the ages of the parties and the names and occupations of their fathers, and further, to register the information twice over in duplicate register books supplied by the General Register Office. Every quarter, a copy of the entries during the previous three months was sent to the local Superintendent Registrar for onward transmission to the General Register Office, where they were indexed. When the duplicate register books were full, one would be retained by the church and the other sent to the local Superintendent Registrar. The format of marriage registers and the system of registration remains substantially unchanged to the present day.

If I cannot find a marriage in the parish I expected, where else can I look?

Lord Hardwicke's Act of 1753 also required for the first time the registration of banns of marriage, either in the marriage register or in a separate volume. In accordance with immemorial custom, banns were called in the parishes of residence of both parties to a marriage, which itself would have to be performed in one of the two parishes. The practice of registering banns tended to fall into disuse towards the

end of the eighteenth century, but was revived by the Marriage Act of 1822, which required the keeping of separate banns registers, and since then it has been adhered to consistently. Entries in banns registers record the names and parishes of origin of both parties to a marriage, and dates on which the banns were called. In more recent times incumbents have sometimes annotated the entries with whether and when the marriage actually took place. The *survival of banns registers is very haphazard*, particularly for the half century after Lord Hardwicke's Act. However, they can be used for finding out where a marriage actually took place if one knows the parish of origin of only one of the parties. It should be remembered that a marriage could take place without the calling of banns if the parties to it obtained either a licence from the bishop or, after 1837, a certificate from the local Superintendent Registrar.

What information can I find in baptism and burial registers?

The registers of baptisms and burials generally kept to the same format from 1538 to 1812, although in a very few parishes printed register volumes were used for baptisms and burials from 1783, in connection with the imposition of Stamp Duty. The form for baptisms recorded name, parents, and dates of birth and christening, and the form for burials, the name, age and parish of the deceased, and date of burial.

Rose's Act of 1812, already mentioned with regard to the registration of marriages, also required the introduction of separate volumes of printed forms of baptism and burial registers from 1st January 1813. The baptism registers record the date of baptism, the name of the child, the names of the parents, the profession and abode of the father, and occasionally the names of godparents. Dates of birth are also sometimes recorded in marginal notes. The burial registers record the name, age and abode of the deceased. Both types of register continue in use to the present day.

Will I find dates of birth and death?

Parish registers were required to give the date of the baptism and the burial of the people involved. It was not until the introduction of civil registration in 1837 that dates of birth and death had to be registered in any official records in England and Wales. A few members of the clergy chose to include the date of birth of the child being baptised but it was more usual only to give an indication of their age and this was at the discretion of the individual incumbent. Dates of birth are not routinely entered into the baptism registers until the present century. Similarly many clergymen noted the age of the person they were burying and in most cases this would have been within a few days of their death, but the actual date of death will not usually be given.

Coverage of the population

Who can you expect to find in the registers?

Although the Church of England was supposed to encompass everyone, this theory of universality never held true. For various reasons, *many people will not be recorded in the relevant parish registers*. Some nonconformists were included, and some were not, depending on a number of factors such as the diligence of the Anglican incumbent, or on the strength of the nonconformist's desire to be able to prove his marriage or the age of his children.

Did everyone have to marry in church?

Much the most reliable category of parish registers is that of marriages, at least from 1754 to 1837. *Until 1754 it was strictly speaking unnecessary to have a marriage ceremony*, but such marriages, though valid, were irregular and most people therefore married in church. During the Commonwealth, ecclesiastical marriage was entirely replaced by a civil ceremony, although many Anglican ministers were licensed to perform this civil service, and so the marriages may still be recorded in the parish registers. However, after the passing of Hardwicke's Marriage Act, 1753, marriage could only take place in the parish church of one of the parties, on pain of transportation for fourteen years, the only exceptions to this rule being made for Quakers and Jews. Thus every marriage that took place after the 1753 Act should be recorded in the parish registers, although strict nonconformists and Catholics continued to marry illicitly or to have a second ceremony of their own. The reforms of 1837 allowed nonconformists and Roman Catholics to perform their own marriage services registered separately.

Where were people buried?

The coverage of burial registers is affected by a number of factors. For the first two centuries or so they would include most nonconformists and Roman Catholics, if only because there was nowhere else for them to be buried except the parish churchyard. After the Toleration Act, 1689, a number of nonconformist chapels opened their own burial grounds, but there do not appear to have been many of these in Derbyshire. By the Burial Laws (Amendment) Act, 1880, a deceased person could be buried in a parish churchyard with a non-Anglican religious service, or with no service at all, and despite the evident hostility of some clergy, advantage was taken of this in certain areas by nonconformists and others in considerable numbers.

After the passing of the *Burial Act, 1853, cemeteries were opened under the control of elected burial boards* in many places where the parish churchyards were full. In these circumstances the churchyards would normally be closed by order-in-council. The most notable example of this happening is in *Derby, where all the churchyards were closed in 1855 upon the opening of the Nottingham Road Cemetery*. Normally when burials in a churchyard cease, the series of burial registers comes to an end,

but in some parishes with closed churchyards incumbents continue to use the register of burials to record burial of ashes in the churchyard, interments in the local authority cemetery, or even a funeral service before cremation.

Where else might people have been registered?

Despite their many defects and omissions, parish registers are the main source for genealogy between 1538 and 1837, but registers of other denominations must also be taken into account. Details of holdings of records of nonconformist, Roman Catholic and other religious organisations can be found in the *Derbyshire Record Office Guide*, in the *Nonconformist Register List* and in finding aids available for reference in the Record Office Search Room.

The Parochial Structure of the Church of England

What is a parish?

In order to use this guide to best advantage, it is necessary to understand the parochial administration of the Church of England and how it has developed, particularly in the last two centuries. The parish was originally considered to be the area centred on a particular church and within which the *Acure* of souls (responsibility for the ministrations of the church) was in the charge of a particular clergyman, the incumbent, appointed for the purpose. It was a different entity from the township, which can be defined as a settlement or community or a group of hamlets in a legal or quasi-corporate guise, having various rights and obligations, eg the appointment of a constable.

The division of England into parishes was more or less complete by about 1200, and there was very little change in their boundaries for the next six centuries. In Derbyshire the pattern of parishes was very variable. There were a few parishes consisting of only one township, eg Pinxton, but generally each parish comprised two or more townships. Derby was an exception in that it formed one township but was divided into four, later five, distinct parishes. Some parishes - Bakewell is best example - were so large that at an early date it was considered unreasonable for people living in the more distant townships to attend the parish church regularly. In these cases, *chapels* were built, and displayed greatly varying degrees of independence from the mother church. Some, known as *chapels of ease*, had no particular district assigned to them, while others served distinct parts, or *chapelries*, of the mother parishes. Some, such as Turnditch before 1780, were not licensed for baptisms or marriages, or did not have a churchyard consecrated for burials, and these functions remained reserved to the parish church, whereas in other chapels some or all of these functions were provided. Some, such as Ballidon, were served by the same clergyman as was the parish church; others were provided with separate benefices, and were accordingly served by perpetual curates; others again such as Baslow were virtually separate parishes in all but name and are known as

parochial chapelries.

Extra-parochial liberties

At the other extreme there were some small areas, such as Sinfin Moor and Codnor Park, which on account of their lack of population when parishes were being formed, or for some other reason, were not considered to be part of any parish. These are known as *extra-parochial* places or *extra-parochial liberties*. The inhabitants of extra-parochial places normally attended church in one of the neighbouring parishes.

What are 'peculiaris' ?

Some parishes were exempt from the jurisdiction of the Bishop, and were under the control of either another ecclesiastical official, such as the Dean and Chapter of Lichfield cathedral in the case of Kniveton, or of a layman as in the case of Calke or Dale Abbey. These parishes were known as *peculiaris*, those being under lay control often being called private peculiaris. As a result of legislation in the course of the nineteenth century, peculiaris were gradually subjected to the jurisdiction of the bishops and absorbed into the normal jurisdiction of the church.

Churches and chapels such as St. John's, Ashbourne, outside the structure of parish and chapelry, but nevertheless subject to the jurisdiction of the bishop, are known as extra-parochial chapels. In only very few cases are these licensed for baptisms or marriages or have a churchyard for burials.

Why are there very many registers in Derbyshire which begin in the nineteenth century?

In the late eighteenth century and throughout the nineteenth and twentieth centuries there was a rapid increase in population, and significant movement of people to the coalfields and to the new industrial towns. These factors rendered the existing parochial divisions totally inadequate in many areas. To deal with this, the existing structure was rationalised; more churches were built and new parishes were created. Gradually most of the existing chapelries were licensed for baptisms, marriages and burials if they had not been already, and were then separated off into distinct parishes. In the more populous areas new churches were built, usually as chapels of ease to existing parish churches, but after a few years many of the new chapelries were formed into separate parishes, such as Cromford, originally in the parish of Wirksworth. Some of the new churches, however, have not progressed beyond the status of chapelry, sometimes licensed for baptisms and marriages, and sometimes not. The process of forming new parishes, which were often known at first as conventional districts, ecclesiastical districts or consolidated chapelries, is a continuing one, though it has slowed down considerably in the twentieth century.

Why is it important to know which are ancient parishes?

More recently there has been a contrary trend of merging neighbouring parishes. Some of the new parishes arising from merger have, confusingly, more than one parish church within their boundaries. An example is the parish of Buxton with Burbage and King Sterndale, formed from the three former parishes comprised in its title and containing three parish churches as well as three chapels of ease. The trend to create Team Ministries is one that is likely to continue in the Church of England in the future.

SECONDARY SOURCES

a) *International Genealogical Index (IGI)*

This is a name index produced by the Genealogical Society of Utah from copies of documents, especially church registers of baptisms, banns and marriages, up to about 1900. It is available on CD-ROM or microfiche in many record offices - including Derbyshire Record Office - and libraries.

b) *Monumental Inscriptions*

Inscriptions on gravestones - details may not always be accurate - have been transcribed by many local groups. Copies, usually arranged by place, are available in many record offices and libraries.

c) *Pedigrees*

Printed pedigrees may exist for landed families, for example, in *Heralds' Visitations* of the 17th century and later. Copies of these and of family trees of a wide variety of people may be found in record offices and libraries.

d) *Newspapers*

Local newspapers can include notices of births, marriages and deaths, obituaries, reports of funerals; reports of coroners' inquests, trials and many types of local events. Microfilm copies are available in many libraries.

e) *Trade Directories*

19th and 20th century directories list prominent landowners, local officials and tradesmen, usually by surname and by trade. Microform and printed editions are widely available in record offices and libraries.

CHURCH OF ENGLAND REGISTERS

Introduction

The list which follows gives details of parish registers which have been deposited in the Record Office as Diocesan Record Office for the Diocese of Derby.

The Parochial Registers and Records Measure (amended 1992) requires that all non-current parish records over 100 years old must be deposited with the Record Office unless stringent storage conditions can be met by the parish concerned. Where registers have been deposited, the covering dates have been given. If this space is blank, registers are not yet in the Record Office but may still be in the parish concerned.

This list is arranged alphabetically by name of parish or chapelry, and also includes names of townships with cross-references to the parishes in which they are or have been situated. Some hamlets are also included with suitable cross-references to avoid confusion. Under the name of each parish or chapelry are brief notes detailing the places now contained within it, and, where appropriate, the places formerly contained in it but now split off to form separate parishes, and the dates when this happened. In the case of new parishes and chapelries, dates of formation and licensing for particular functions are given, as far as these can be ascertained, as well as the names of the parishes from which they were carved out.

Overall covering dates have been given for the registers held in the original and on microfilm and DVD. These dates indicate where there are gaps owing to loss of registers. Some gaps occurring within individual registers, particularly common in the earlier ones, have been shown in this guide, but not all of them have been listed.

Where microfilm and DVD copies are available, readers will be required to use them in order to preserve the originals from further wear.
