Offering community facilities to the public

## What is the Staveley Centre?

It is the first purpose built Community Care Centre owned by Derbyshire County Council. There are a wide range of community and meeting rooms, exhibition space and therapy rooms for hire along with a modern Bistro catering for every taste. In addition, it is home to award winning specialist residential care particularly for those people with dementia and there are many daytime activities for older people and carers.

## Where is it?

The centre is on Calver Crescent, off Middlecroft Road, the postcode is S43 3LY



## When is it open?

The centre is open between 8am and 5pm Monday to Friday. Weekends and evenings by arrangement.

There is plenty of free car parking available and good access to public transport with a regular bus service stopping close by on Middlecroft Road.

The centre has excellent disabled access and designated disabled car parking spaces.

## What has the centre got to offer?

Facilities that are open to the public include:

- **The Bistro** - with a home cooked menu of tasty light snacks, freshly prepared sandwiches, wholesome soups, hot daily specials and delicious pastries and cakes. Also on offer is a range of coffees, hot chocolate and plain or flavoured teas. Why not call in and try it out? It's open 8am till 4pm Monday to Friday.



- Our **health and wellbeing zone** allows you a quiet and comfy environment to browse a wide range of health and wellbeing information





### Community activity and meeting rooms for hire:

- Four meeting rooms of various sizes available for private, charitable and commercial use.
- These rooms can be booked on an hourly basis, please ring or email us for details and pricing.
- Rooms can accommodate between 2 and 30 people and can be used for a range of activities or meetings.
- Two of the rooms are suitable as treatment and therapy rooms and could be used to host a yoga class, to run reiki or hypnotherapy sessions or chiropody or physiotherapy clinics.



- A light, airy and open reception and communal area is well suited for displaying **small exhibitions or static displays or information stalls**.
- Our helpful and friendly **Reception staff** are on duty whenever the Centre is open.
- The Bistro can also provide **refreshments and hot or cold buffets** for any occasion catering for community meetings, corporate functions or family/birthday parties.
- Our **internet café** workstations offer free wifi and laptops to be used on site so you could get away from the office for a peaceful coffee whilst still being able to read your emails! Just drop into the Centre to get online.
- A 'state of the art' **hairstressing salon** is now open for business on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.
