Residential means living somewhere day and night.



If you stay in a residential home for less than 3 weeks this is called short term care.



If you stay in a residential home for more than 3 weeks but will be going back to your own home this is called temporary care.



If you go to live in a residential home this is called long term care.



If you go into a residential home you might need to pay towards the cost

How much will you have to pay?

You will have an assessment to see how much you will need to pay. This means we will look at



- the money and savings you have



- the benefits you get



- if you own a house

You will be able to keep £30.15 a week. This is called your personal expenses allowance. This is to spend on things like



- clothes



- presents



- having your hair done



- toiletries like soap and toothpaste
