

  	<p>that having this meeting has had a good impact on County Board because it gives them a chance to talk about things that they might have took to other meetings before.</p> <p><i>The agenda for this meeting was amended. The item on Men's Health has been moved to the next meeting and replaced with Summary Care Records and Flagging.</i></p> <p>Summary Care Records (SCR)</p> <p>We watched a video about Summary Care Records. If you are registered with a GP you will have a SCR. This contains basic information about your health and can be accessed by out of hours services and emergency care providers. You can ask for things to be added to your SCR such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ♦ Medicines you can or cannot take ♦ Hospitals you are happy to go to, or ones you want to avoid ♦ Carer information, like who to call if something happens to you ♦ Things to make the process easier and will help to put you at ease, like 'I like to talk about football'. <p>You are able to ask at your GP Surgery to see a copy of your SCR. GPs are aware that people are being told they can add information to their record. If you want to add something, you need to complete a consent form. 	<p>in the general public find out about this sort of thing. They would like GPs to start talking about SCRs during annual health checks. Rachel said how GPs get £140 per annual health check.</p> <p>Flagging</p> <p>Flagging is the term given to certain notes about reasonable adjustments that appear on your GP records. For example if you have asked to make sure that information is always wrote down for you at the end of an appointment, or you have asked to make sure you always have a double appointment. The receptionist will be able to see these notes. The group watched a video about flagging. You need to ask your GP surgery to add flags to your record if you think they will help.</p> <p>If your GP refers you to hospital, you can ask that they list any flags on your referral so that the hospital know about them.</p> <p>These will not automatically appear on your Summary Care Record.</p> <p>Katie's presentation</p> <p>All the LD Reps have been tasked with giving short presentations to the other Reps during their Reps on Board meetings. This gives them chance to practice collecting information and putting it together in a way that it can be shared with other people. Today Katie shared her presentation about holidays with the Board. She showed us photos and told us about places she had been to and what she had seen there.
