



You might get a virus</li> <li>◆ Say no if an online friend asks for money or photos of you without all of your clothes on if you are unhappy</li> <li>◆ Tell somebody you trust if somebody online makes you feel uncomfortable</li> <li>◆ Remember that you can block people from contacting you online. It was agreed that the next meeting would have less items to discuss</p> <p>Steve went to County Board for the first time. He found it interesting and useful</p> <p>The Amber Valley carers said that there was some friction and It would be good to see everyone working better together</p> <p>A carer said that “carers should voice their problems at carers meetings instead of at County Board. Carers need to be retrained not to bring their own frustrations to these meetings, but to remember to represent the whole community of carers. Carers have to fight for the rights of their loved ones, but it is not the correct forum to do so at partnership boards. Derbyshire is not perfect but its services for the learning disabled are much better than in many other counties such as Staffordshire and Derby City in my experience.”</p>
