Community Connectors is a free service for people with a learning disability or autism. We help people who live in Derbyshire and who are 18 and over to be more active and involved in their local community.

You can talk to a Community Connector about:



- People and friends that are important to you



- What you enjoy doing
- What you are good at



- What you would like to learn
- What you want to do

Community Connectors work with people for up to 12 weeks helping them to find and take part in things they would like to do. The Community Connector will be able to work alongside you, helping you to do things on your own. This can be during the day, evenings or at weekends.

Community Connectors can help you to:



- Use public transport safely and independently.



- Find groups that you would like to join and meet new people
- Try new activities and learn new skills.



- Look for paid and voluntary work and then support you while you do it.
