Day Service

Caring for older people - caring for you

Blackwell Resource Centre is a Derbyshire County Council day service which operates within Bolsover District Council area of Tibshelf, South Normanton and Pinxton (including all villages within that area).

We provide services in two bases, using Bolsover District Council's sheltered housing premises, at Blackwell and Pinxton. Our service operates Monday to Friday, 9am to 3pm.

3 days a week, sessions are specifically arranged to provide appropriate services for people with a Dementia. All staff are highly motivated and have been fully trained to work with people with dementia.

We work alongside health and social care professionals and have close links with other non-profit making organisations such as Derbyshire Carers and the Alzheimer's Society.

We have also developed a monthly Carers Group, who meet in the local area.

We are holders of the Derbyshire Dignity Award and have renewed the award (option 2) to continue to ensure we maintain this high standard. We promote exercise and wellbeing within all our services. Our emphasis is on the individual needs of our clients.

Carers are supported and included in all aspects of the care planning of the person they support, particularly about how they will spend their time with us.

Each person in our Dementia Groups, will return home with a record of their food intake, mood, points of enjoyment, pictorial records and other activities.



What we offer

We offer a choice of stimulating activities to suit your preferences and abilities.

- Chair based exercises (by qualified leaders), arts, music, crafts and quizzes are just a few of the activity options.
- We like to include your specific interests and hobbies in planned activities if we can.
- A planned programme of activities is produced, in consultation with all members.
- We will create a personal service plan tailored to your individual needs.
- You will be served a nutritious two course lunch made from fresh produce and prepared locally.
- All diets can be catered for.
- For a nominal charge, a 'take-home' tea can be provided.
- It is possible for us to offer a bathing service if this need is required.
